I am writing in reference to your letter to Nicholas Molnar and Raymond & Grace Yu dated February 3, 2012 regarding the above referenced site. We would like to request a several month extension to the due date for the Site Conceptual Model as we are still in the process of selecting a new consultant to do this work. We hope to contract with a new consultant within the next several weeks. As we will be working with a new consultant (due to reimbursement constraints with the UST Fund) it will take some time for them to review historical site information and data as well as develop an SCM. We plan to collect a round of groundwater monitoring data during the month of April in accordance with the letter and your previous extension grant (email dated 3/1/12).

We have been actively working on obtaining reimbursement for previous work in 2006 and 2008. This has required a significant effort and we have finally successfully obtained EDFs from the laboratories in acceptable format for uploading to Geotracker (all but one as of today).
