
Subject: Notification of Intent to Proceed with the Proposed 5 Consecutive Day (24-hour/Day) Multi-Phase Extraction Event

On September 25, 2008, Thrifty submitted a Feasibility Study and Corrective Action Plan (FS/CAP) prepared by GeoHydrologic Consultants, Inc. for former Thrifty Oil Co. (Thrifty) Station #049 located at 3400 San Pablo Avenue, Oakland, California which proposed a 5 consecutive day (24-hour/day) MPE event with combined soil vapor and groundwater extraction from wells MW-2R, MW-4R, and RW-1R. Since more than 60-days have passed since the submission of the FS/CAP and no response has been received from the ACHCS, Thrifty will proceed with the scope of work proposed in the FS/CAP under the "60 day rule" pursuant to authority granted in California Code of Regulation, Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 6, Section 2722(e).
