### RE: LNAPL Recovery Status Report

Dear Mr. Detterman:

On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron), Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) is pleased to submit this *Light Non-Aqueous Phase Liquid (LNAPL) Recovery Status Report* for Chevron 90504, which is located at 15900 Hesperian Blvd., San Leandro, Alameda County, California (the Site – *Figure 1*). This report was prepared at the request of the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health Services (ACDEHS) in correspondence dated July 13, 2012 (*Appendix A*).

## LNAPL Monitoring and Recovery Summary

To facilitate LNAPL recovery efforts during the month of August 2012, Stantec monitored well C-2 weekly for LNAPL thickness. This well is located along the western edge of the Site between Hesperian Blvd. and the underground storage tanks (USTs; shown on *Figure 2*). If LNAPL was measured in well C-2, the LNAPL (generally a mixture of LNAPL and groundwater) was recovered using disposable bailers and stored on Site in a 35-gallon drum with a 55-gallon drum used as over-pack. During each LNAPL monitoring and recovery event, one (1) new SoakEase<sup>™</sup> absorbent sock was placed inside a stainless steel canister in well C-2 with the bottom of the sock positioned approximately one foot below the measured static groundwater level. Following replacement of the absorbent sock in well C-2, the used absorbent sock was stored in the 35-gallon drum on Site. Weekly LNAPL monitoring and recovery field data sheets are included in *Appendix B*.

Observations of LNAPL in well C-2 during August 2012 included:

- LNAPL thickness was measured at 0.10 feet on August 3, 2012;
- LNAPL thickness was measured at 0.08 feet on August 10, 2012; and
- No measureable LNAPL was observed on August 15, August 24, and August 30, 2012.

Based on calculations using LNAPL thickness, the August 2012 totals for well C-2 include:

- A total of approximately 200 milliliters (0.053 gallons) of LNAPL were recovered; and
- A total of approximately 5 Liters (1.32 gallons) of total fluids (LNAPL and groundwater mixture) were recovered.

### Waste

No LNAPL disposal occurred during the month of August 2012. There is currently one 35-gallon drum on Site containing approximately 1.3 gallons of LNAPL and groundwater mixture. This drum is stored in a 55-gallon drum as over-pack. Used absorbent socks are also stored in the drum. The drum is labeled and stored on Site pending waste profile evaluation by Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA). CRA will arrange for the waste to be removed and disposed of by a California-licensed waste hauler. The recovered LNAPL and groundwater will be disposed of by a waste disposal company in accordance with all applicable regulatory requirements.

### Recommendations

Stantec will continue to monitor levels of LNAPL in well C-2 and present the results in quarterly groundwater monitoring and LNAPL recovery reports according to the schedule provided by the ACDEHS in their correspondence dated July 13, 2012. Due to the limited accumulation of LNAPL observed in well C-2 during August 2012, Stantec will reduce the frequency of LNAPL monitoring and recovery events from weekly to monthly starting September 2012. The frequency may be further adjusted as necessary based on future field observations.





Dear Ms. Fischer, and Messrs. Bohannon and Webster:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file for the above-referenced site, including the 2012 Annual Groundwater Monitoring and Sampling Report, dated May 15, 2012 prepared by Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) of Rancho Cordova, California.

Review of the referenced report indicates that well C-2 contained 0.30 feet of Light Non-Aqueous Phase Liquid (LNAPL) described to be light brown in color. In discussing the discovery with the UST inspector in the County's CUPA Program, it is understood that troubles with the diesel turbine pump were recently encountered at the site. Based on the history of non-detectable results at this well, and the reported presence of LNAPL, this appears to be a new release.

Based on the review of the case file ACEH requests that you address the following technical comments and send us the documents requested below.

### **TECHNICAL COMMENTS**

- Request to Abate and Recover LNAPL As noted above, the recent discovery of LNAPL at the site indicates a new release of fuel product from the UST system at the site. As a consequence, ACEH requests continuing, appropriate, and timely efforts to abate and recover the LNAPL product from the site. Quick efforts will minimize the environmental consequences associated with the release. ACEH requests the submittal of a status report by the date identified below.
- 2. Request to Work With CUPA The new release indicates that the tank system should be tested to determine the release source as liquids have not been reported to have been detected in tank system sumps. ACEH requests that Chevron work with the County's CUPA inspector to achieve this request. County CUPA personnel have been made aware of the release and are copied with this letter.
- 3. Revised Groundwater Monitoring Schedule The site has been on an annual groundwater monitoring schedule pending review for potential closure; however, the presence of LNAPL indicates the schedule should be revised to a quarterly schedule while the LNAPL is recovered in order to determine associated environmental consequences at the site. In addition to well C-2, this is initially requested to include wells C-1, C-7, and C-8. The remaining wells can remain on the existing annual schedule until otherwise determined appropriate by analytical results in the wells more proximal to the release location.

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.
