Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the fuel leak case file for the above-referenced site and the recently submitted report entitled, "*Risk Evaluation and Case Closure Request*," dated October 29, 2008. The report, which was prepared on Shell's behalf by Conestoga-Rovers & Associates, presents a screening level risk evaluation of the potential risk to receptors from the site and requests case closure. The case is currently under consideration for case closure by ACEH. During the review for possible case closure, groundwater monitoring may be suspended. Following completion of ACEH review and California Regional Water Quality Control Board concurrence, the case will be closed or ACEH will provide further directives for investigation or cleanup.
