Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) has reviewed the case file and the recently submitted document *Request to Eliminate Groundwater Monitoring* (Request) dated March 11, 2015 and prepared by ARCADIS U.S. Inc. (ARCADIS) for the subject fuel leak case. The Request was prepared following a review and analysis of 20 years of groundwater concentration data conducted by ARCADIS indicating the contaminant plume does not appear to be migrating down gradient and that the petroleum hydrocarbons are actively being reduced through anaerobic degradation.

At this time, ACEH is in agreement that, until further notice, the groundwater monitoring program for the subject fuel leak cases may be suspended.
