The purpose of this letter is to respond to the information you sent me via telefax on September 21, 1994, which sets forth the reason John Morrell & Company ("John Morrell") was named as a Responsible Party at the Jackson Street site.

The Pre-Enforcement Review Panel appears to have misinterpreted the relationship between John Morrell and other named Responsible Parties. The Board's letter of April 27, 1994, and a similar letter of January 18, 1994 indicate that John Morrell was a successor corporation to the East Bay Packing Company, whose parent was Hunter/Krey/Kretschmar and/or Kretschmar Brands. However, as explained by Mr. Charlie Robbins, General Counsel to John Morrell, in his letter of March 28, 1994, John Morrell purchased only the rights to certain intellectual property of Kretschmar. Thus, it was not a "successor" corporation as the April 27, 1994 notice indicates.

None of the other information that your office has provided to me indicates that John Morrell either owned the property at the time of or following the release of petroleum, or owned or operated the USTs immediately before the discontinuation of their use. First, Jennifer Eberle of your Agency provided a chain of title to me that showed that John Morrell owned the property prior to November 12, 1970. Merely being a past owner does not support the conclusion that John Morrell owned the property at the time of the release. Moreover, I have seen no technical information that supports a conclusion that petroleum

products were released from the USTs during John Morrell's ownership almost twenty-five years ago.

Second, based on my discussions with an employee of John Morrell who worked at the Jackson Street site during John Morrell's ownership, later site owners used the USTs that were removed from the property in 1990. This fact suggests strongly that the USTs were not leaking and in good working order during John Morrell's ownership of the property. It also reflects that John Morrell was not the owner or operator of the USTs immediately before the discontinuation of their use and therefore cannot be a Responsible Party for that reason alone.

In sum, John Morrell maintains that none of the information your Agency has provided supplies any reasonable basis for naming John Morrell as a Responsible Party at the Jackson Street site. If there is any other information that would support the conclusion that John Morrell owned or operated the site at the time of the release of the petroleum substances, please forward that material to me.

Finally, I recently learned that John Morrell received an invoice for oversight costs incurred by your office for the first six months of 1994. However, I understand that the current property owner has been paying these oversight costs, and there is therefore no need for John Morrell to respond to the invoice.

After you have reviewed this letter, please call me at your earliest convenience to discuss. I appreciate your time and consideration.

It has been brought to my attention by Regional Board staff that a condition of soil and groundwater pollution exists on the property located at 208 Jackson, Oakland CA 94607, as a result of an underground storage tank release. The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACHD) staff have requested technical reports from you to fulfill your obligations per California Code of Regulations, Article 11, Corrective Action Requirements. It is my understanding that ACHD staff were unsuccessful in eliciting your co-operation in resolving these issues through normal correspondence.

A Pre-Enforcement Review Panel was held at ACHD offices on January 18, 1994, attended by Mr. Richard Hiett of my staff. Pursuant to the Regional Board's authority under Section 13267 (b) of the California Water Code, you are hereby required to April 27, 1994 STID 3707 page 2 of 3

submit a technical report within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter to address soil and groundwater pollution at this site. The technical report should specifically address the following numbered items:

- a workplan to define the extent of groundwater hydrocarbon pollution;
- 2) commencement of quarterly groundwater monitoring and sampling for TPHg, TPHd, and BTEX;
- 3) submittal of quarterly groundwater monitoring and sampling reports to ACHD;
- 4) well surveying with respect to mean sea level;
- 5) a detailed description of work performed in regards to a storage tank removed from inside the building;

All work should adhere to the requirements of the <u>Tri-Regional</u>
Board Staff Recommendations for the <u>Preliminary Evaluation and</u>
Investigation of <u>Underground Storage Tank Sites--August 10, 1990</u>, and Article 11 of Title 23, Waters, California Code of Regulations.

This request is based on the evidence submitted to the Pre-Enforcement Review Panel, as well as the documentary record. East Bay Packing Co., its parent companies Kretschmar Brands Inc. and Hunter/Krey/Kretschmar, and its successor corporation, John Morrell & Co., are responsible parties as per Section 2720 of Article 11 of Title 23, Waters, California Code of Regulations, in that they "owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use," and they "had or has control over a underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance." record indicates that Kretschmar Brands Inc. is the parent corporation of East Bay Packing Co., and that John Morrell & Co. is the successor corporation to East Bay Packing Co. John Morrell & Co. is listed on the attached documentation as a successor corporation to Kretschmar Brands Inc; this, in fact, is not true. John Morrell & Co. purchased only the Kretschmar trademark and inventory, and therefore cannot be considered a successor company. We will gladly submit an affidavit to this effect, if necessary. It has been brought to my attention by Regional Board staff that a condition of soil and groundwater pollution exists on the property located at 208 Jackson, Oakland CA 94607, as a result of an underground storage tank release. The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACHD) staff have requested technical reports from you to fulfill your obligations per California Code of Regulations, Article 11, Corrective Action Requirements. It is my understanding that ACHD staff were unsuccessful in eliciting your co-operation in resolving these issues through normal correspondence.

A Pre-Enforcement Review Panel was held at ACHD offices on January 18, 1994, attended by Mr. Richard Hiett of my staff. Pursuant to the Regional Board's authority under Section 13267 (b) of the California Water Code, you are hereby required to submit a technical report within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter to address soil and groundwater pollution at this site. The technical report should specifically address the following numbered items:

- a workplan to define the extent of groundwater hydrocarbon pollution;
- commencement of quarterly groundwater monitoring and sampling for TPHq, TPHd, and BTEX;
- 3) submittal of quarterly groundwater monitoring and sampling reports to ACHD;
- 4) well surveying with respect to mean sea level;
- 5) a detailed description of work performed in regards to a storage tank removed from inside the building;

All work should adhere to the requirements of the <u>Tri-Regional</u>
<u>Board Staff Recommendations for the Preliminary Evaluation and</u>
<u>Investigation of Underground Storage Tank Sites--August 10, 1990,</u>
and Article 11 of Title 23, Waters, California Code of
Regulations.

This request is based on the evidence submitted to the Pre-Enforcement Review Panel, as well as the documentary record. East Bay Packing Co., its parent companies Kretschmar Brands Inc. and Hunter/Krey/Kretschmar, and its successor corporations, Courtenay Corp., and John Morrell & Co., are responsible parties as per Section 2720 of Article 11 of Title 23, Waters, California Code of Regulations, in that they "owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use," and they "had or has control over a underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance." The record indicates that Kretschmar Brands Inc. is the parent corporation of East Bay Packing Co., and that Courtenay Corporation and John Morrell & Co. are the successor corporations to East Bay Packing Co. - 1) Soils currently stockpiled onsite must be analyzed for TPHg, TPHd, BTEX, and total lead. The rate of sampling depends on whether the soil will be placed back into the excavation. If this soil is found to be clean, it may be placed back in the existing excavation. However, if it is found to be contaminated, it may need to be disposed elsewhere.
- 2) Groundwater sampling must continue on a quarterly basis in all the monitoring wells. Groundwater must be analyzed for TPHg, TPHd, and BTEX.
- Direction of groundwater flow must be determined by measurements taken at the same time as samples are collected.
- 4) Quarterly reports must be submitted to this office, and should include a narrative description of work performed, laboratory reports, field data sheets, and a site map with two adjacent streets and a north arrow.



This office has received and reviewed a data report prepared by Geo-Environmental Technology Incorporated concerning the project being conducted at the facility listed above. It is the opinion of this agency that the excavation of contaminated soil at this site has been sufficiently thorough to ensure that all soil with diesel contamination exceeding 1,000 parts per million has been removed. (No further soil excavation is required at this site.)

Excavated soil with diesel contamination which equals or exceeds 1,000 parts per million requires disposal as a hazardous waste or must be subjected to a hazardous waste classification determination as detailed in Article 11, of Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations.

Guidelines established by the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board state that certain follow-up actions are required whenever soil hydrocarbon contamination associated with an underground storage tank equal to or exceeding 100 parts per million is detected. Specifically, a ground water quality investigation must be implemented.

The goals of such a program are to:

- 1) Identify the ground water flow gradient.
- 2) Determine whether a plume of contamination is present in either the ground water or overlying soil.
- 3) Determine the extent of any such plume by identifying the zero line, beyond which no contamination can be detected.
- 4) Actively treat ground water to reduce unacceptable levels of contamination.
- 5) Monitor ground water quality on a quarterly basis for a minimum of two years.

The Guidelines of the Regional Board specify that the ground water gradient must be determined from data derived from three wells.
