Hello Gene,

Probably the best way to claim the site is to go to either the link listed on the letter requesting the site be claimed, or to the following, which is one step further along. Go to -

<u>http://www.swrcb.ca.gov/ust/electronic\_submittal/index.shtml</u> and then call the toll free number in the upper right corner. The Help Desk can walk you through the process. Since I've not claimed a site, I don't really know how it's done; so the Help Desk would be your best bet.

So you are aware, the County also has a database with reports on a site in PDF format; see the link below my contact info. Click "Find a Site" on right or left column, then on the next page "Click here to link to the AcrIMS site". Likely you'll need to temporarily allow pop ups. Don't use the map that will eventfully appear. Use the "search" tab at the top of the blue column on the right, then use the following drop down menus: "LOP Document Search" and "Record ID – RO Number". Then type in the last significant digits of your RO (case number; which is 17 in your case). Most likely a number of cases will pop up, but select yours to see what we have available.

For Geotracker only work since July 2005 is required to be uploaded, the County's web database is more archival. You can find the most recent Directive letters from the County (DIR\_2008-07-14, being the most recent one requesting work). Unfortunately I am not yet familiar with the case. You should also be aware that for the next 4 to 6 months the State has recently mandated full review of all sites under an "Impediments to Closure" review, and this precludes any additional work requests, unless there's risk or pending critical development. So at least I'll be reviewing the case shortly. Hope this helps, and thanks for the contact update. Best,
