Dear Mr. Matthews:

On behalf of Equilon Enterprises LLC dba Shell Oil Products US (Shell), Cambria Environmental Technology, Inc. (Cambria) is submitting this letter pursuant to the conference call held on February 4, 2005 between you and representatives from Shell, Cambria, and Fillner Construction Inc. (Fillner). The subject site location is shown on Figure 1, and the proposed final tank pit dimensions are shown on Figure 2.

PROPOSED OVER-EXCAVATION ACTIVITIES

On January 31, 2005, Fillner uncovered visibly hydrocarbon-impacted soil or fill material in the northeast corner of the tank pit. This was encountered while digging in the tank pit with an excavator. Based on the soil type, this material appears to be non-native fill. On February 1, 2005, Cambria collected two samples of the impacted soil/fill directly from Fillner's backhoe bucket, and submitted them to Severn Trent Laboratories Inc. of Pleasanton, California for analysis. The samples were analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), benzene, ethylbenzene, toluene and xylenes by EPA method 8260B, for total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd) by EPA method 8015M, for total lead by EPA method 6010B, and for hexane extractable material (oil and grease) by EPA method 1664A M. The certified analytical report is included as Attachment A.

The laboratory results for samples SP-5 and SP-6 indicated TPHd concentrations of 130 and 100 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg), TPHg concentrations of 560 and 1,500 mg/kg, benzene concentrations of <2.5 and <0.50 mg/kg, lead concentrations of 4.2 and 8.7 mg/kg, and oil and

grease concentrations of 200 and 61 mg/kg, respectively. The laboratory's notes on the lab reports also indicated that the diesel-range hydrocarbons were in the early diesel range and did not match the laboratory's standard for diesel. Cambria believes this is likely due to the contamination being weathered gasoline, not fuel oil or kerosene, which would be reported as late diesel range hydrocarbons.

As discussed in our February 4, 2005 conference call, Shell will investigate and/or remediate the impacted soil to the extent feasible. In particular, once the new underground storage tanks (USTs) are set and the tank pit is at least partially filled, Fillner will remove the impacted soil to the extent feasible, working under the direction of Cambria and Shell.



To understand the possible sources of the impacted soil/fill, Cambria reviewed the site's environmental investigation history. The site has been under investigation since 1985. In 1992, a release of approximately 200 gallons of gasoline from an unleaded gasoline pipe fitting was reported. Groundwater recovery from the tank backfill well was implemented, removed approximately 40,000 gallons of water, and reportedly reduced the product presence to a sheen. Cambria believes that the observed soil/fill material may have been impacted by this 1992 fuel release. This knowledge, combined with the current laboratory data, suggests to Cambria that the impacted fill/soil is likely due to this prior fuel release, and that it is likely unrelated to fuel oil or kerosene storage tanks.

Cambria anticipates that removal of the impacted soil will largely address your concerns regarding investigating the possible existence of unidentified USTs. During the soil removal activity, Cambria anticipates that additional portions of the paving will be removed and that additional fill/soil will be excavated. Cambria anticipates that this work will indicate the extent of the non-native fill/soil material present, and Cambria will collect soil samples using excavation equipment and/or hand-auger sampling tools to characterize the extent of impacted soils during the soil removal activity.

In addition, Cambria (or a hired subcontractor) will investigate, using a metal detector, the possibility that an abandoned tank is located in the vicinity of the impacted soil. It is our professional opinion that this, combined with investigation during excavation, will be more comprehensive than advancing soil borings in evaluating the possible existence of additional USTs at the site.

DISPOSAL ACTIVITIES

Shell will dispose of soil from the site at Forward Landfill in Manteca, California, based on the laboratory results for stockpile samples collected at the site that meet Forward's non-hazardous waste criteria. Because there was not enough room to stockpile the soil on site, soil removed from the site is transported as non-hazardous material and is currently being held by Forward under a temporary stockpile agreement. Once Cambria submits a waste profile application with all applicable analytical results, the soil will enter the landfill as non-hazardous waste. Forward's acceptance criteria and the temporary stockpile agreement letter are included as Attachment B.



Shell will continue to transport groundwater from the tank pit to the Shell Martinez Refinery for recovery, using vacuum trucks supplied by Philip Services Corporation and/or Onyx Industrial Services, Inc. This water is transported as "non-hazardous" groundwater. For your reference, several bills of lading for water that has already been removed from the site are included as Attachment C. All applicable soil and groundwater laboratory results and disposal documentation will be submitted with the final report documenting the fuel system upgrade, UST replacement, sampling, and over-excavation activities.

CLOSING

On behalf of Shell, Cambria will verbally update you of the project's schedule of activities, including the start and finish of soil excavation, the metal detection investigation, and any additional soil sampling events. Fillner will contact you regarding the schedule for UST, piping, and dispenser replacements and inspections. We appreciate your assistance with this project. 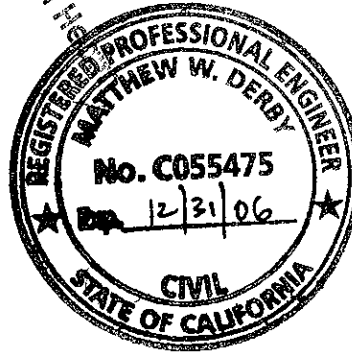

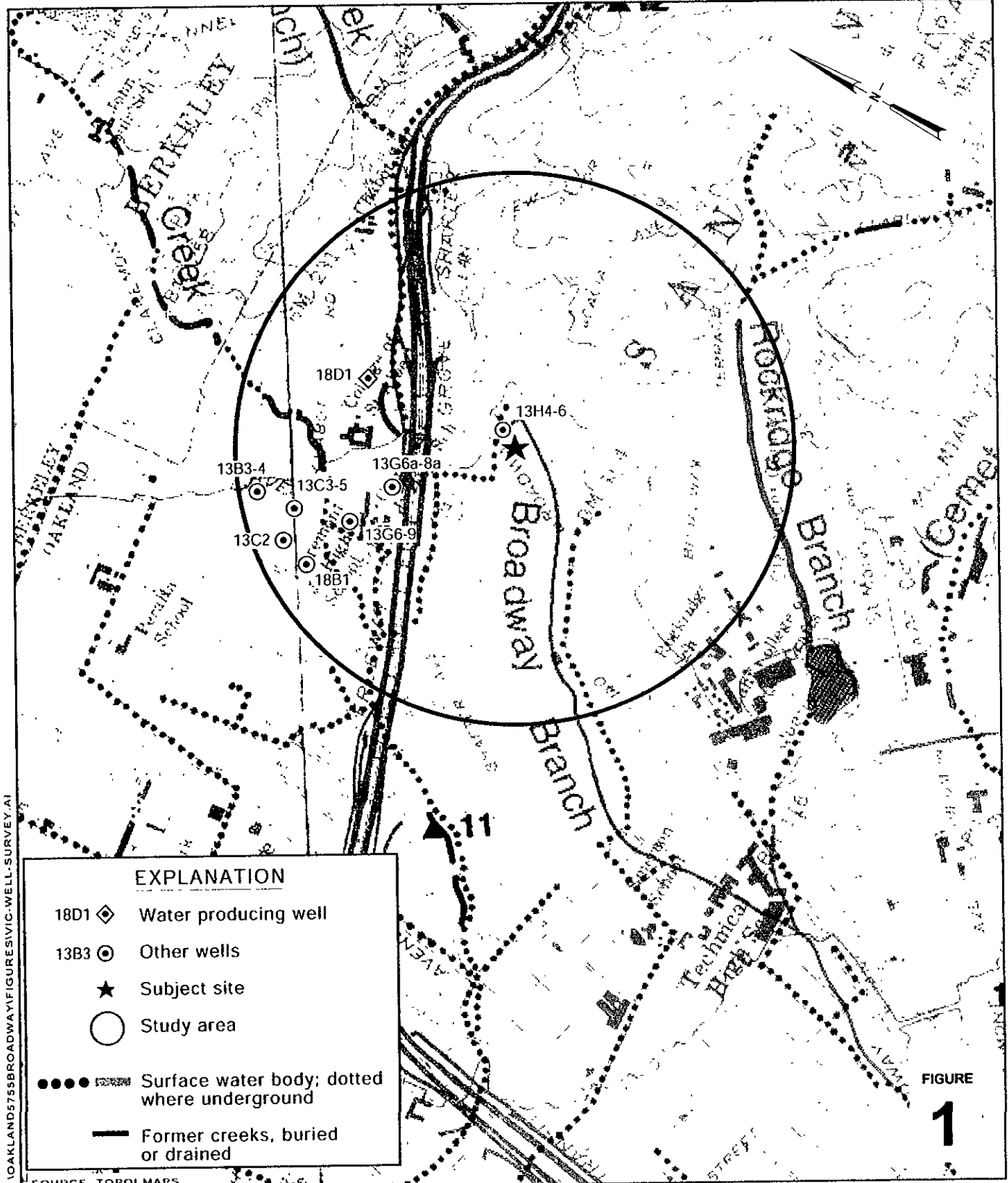

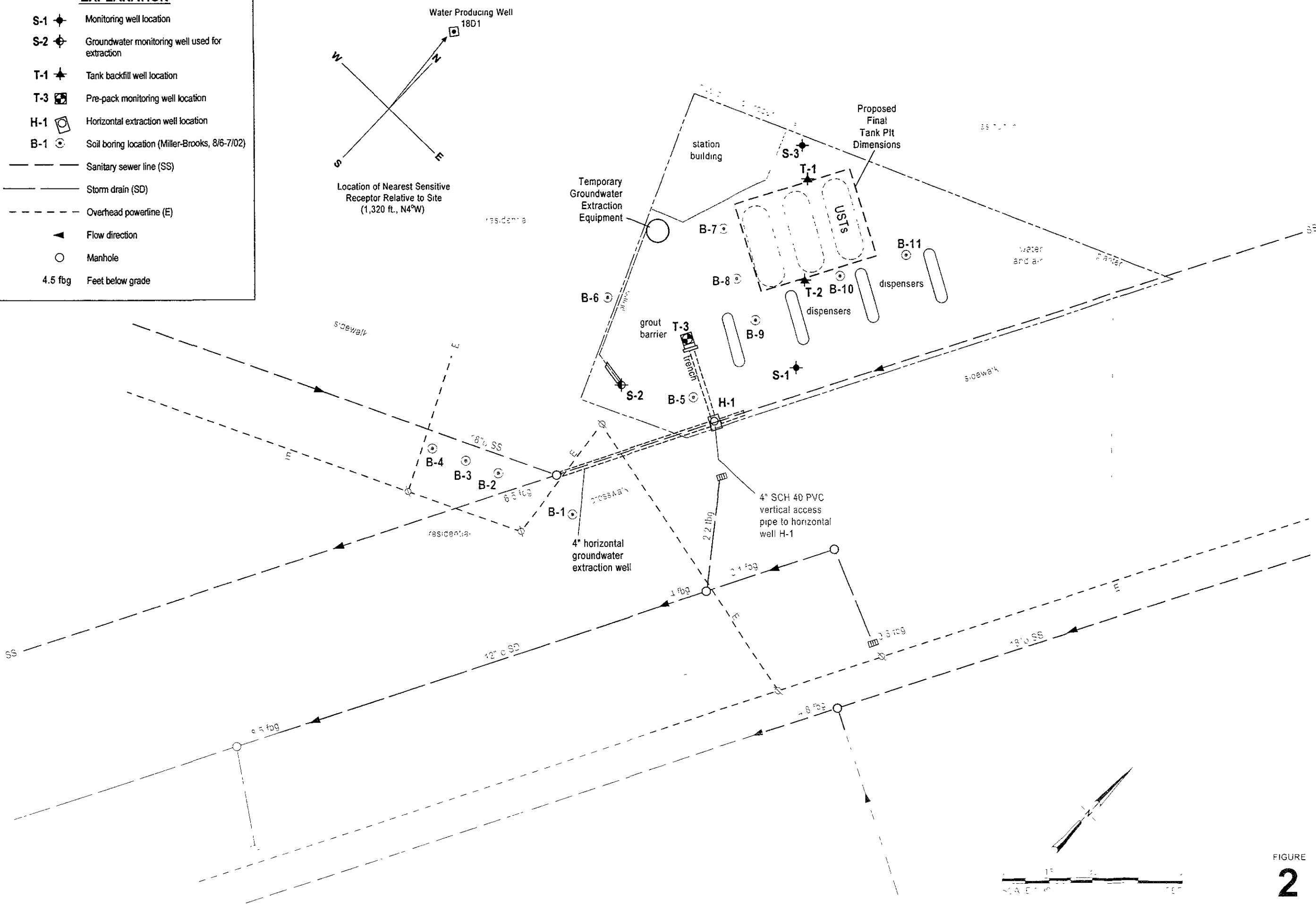
