Ladies and Gentlemen:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACDEH) is considering the above referenced site for potential case closure. As you are aware, numerous site investigations and groundwater monitoring events for underground storage tank leaks have been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. Thank you for submitting the completed *List of Landowners Form* requested in ACDEH's December 1, 2017 Directive Letter.

Due to the residual contamination on site, the site would be closed to existing use as an empty lot with site management requirements that require further evaluation if the site is to be redeveloped in the future.

Public Participation

Public participation is a requirement for the case closure process. In order to notify potentially affected members of the public of the potential fuel leak case closure, ACDEH will distribute the *Notification of Potential Case Closure* to addresses in the immediate vicinity. The *Notification of Potential Case Closure* requests that landowners or residents submit any comments or questions to ACDEH regarding potential case closure. ACDEH will consider all comments from the public prior to potential case closure. ACDEH will provide you with written notification if any comments are received during the following Public Comment Period:

- January 30, 2018 Public Comment Period Begins
- March 31, 2018 Public Comment Period Ends

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Cleanup Oversight Programs, Local Oversight Program (LOP) and Site Cleanup Program (SCP) require submission of all reports in electronic form to the State Water Board's (SWB) GeoTracker website in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Chapter 30, Division3, Title 23 and Division 3, Title 27.

Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) Cases

Reports and deliverable requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party (RP) in conjunction with an unauthorized release from a petroleum underground storage tank (UST) system.

Site Cleanup Program (SCP) Cases

For non-petroleum UST cases, reports and deliverables requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 101480.



The above referenced site is a fuel leak case that is under the regulatory oversight of the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Local Oversight Program for the investigation and cleanup of a release of petroleum hydrocarbons from an underground storage tank system. Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and the site has been evaluated in accordance with the State Water Resources Control Board Low-Threat Closure Policy. The site appears to meet all of the criteria in the Low-Threat Closure Policy. Therefore, ACDEH is considering closure of the fuel leak case. Due to the residual contamination on site, the site would be closed to existing use as an empty lot with site management requirements that require further evaluation if the site is to be redeveloped in the future.
