The LTCP states the following:

Waste Removal – All waste piles, drums, debris and other investigation or remediation derived materials shall be removed from the site and properly managed in accordance with regulatory agency requirements

As per the LTCP and your email below, YRC can right now confirm that any and all remaining investigation and remediation derived waste, not just well destruction derived waste, have been removed from the site.

There is a pending transaction and your prompt approval is much appreciated. I can have a revised report uploaded today if this is acceptable.
