Mr. Nowell,

This letter is in response to your May 21, 2014 request to complete a Well Survey Table and Figure requested by Alameda County Environmental Health in response to the *Request for Case Closure – Site Conceptual Model Request* prepared by Burns & McDonnell on behalf of YRC Worldwide, Inc. Burns & McDonnell has requested well data from the Department of Water Resources (DWR) and Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA) as instructed. At this time, Burns & McDonnell has received well data only from DWR.

The DWR data received does not include well locations, and these locations must be determined by cross-referencing old drilling logs for each well in order for the wells to be plotted accurately in the requested figure. These locations are also required to measure distances from the well to the site, as requested for the Well Survey Table. If the ACPWA data also lacks exact locations, more time will be required to prepare the table and plot the remaining wells. It is unlikely that the ACPWA data will be received before the requested date of July 21, 2014 with enough time for this data analysis and plotting.

On behalf of YRC Worldwide, Inc., Burns & McDonnell is requesting a 60-day extension to complete the Well Survey Table and Figure documents. This will allow time to receive, analyze, and plot the ACPWA well data for a more complete evaluation of the wells and sensitive receptors surrounding the site.
