- 2. Collected groundwater samples from three wells October 2, 2013 in order to evaluate potential former waste oil tank release concerns, as discussed in a previous meeting with the ACEH.
- 3. Submitted *Addendum to the Conceptual Site Model and Case Closure Request* dated November 21, 2013. Results of the October 2, 2013 sampling were documented therein.
- 4. Received a *Landowner and Public Notification* letter from the ACEH dated December 31, 2013, indicating that the Site in the public review period for Case Closure.
