DISCUSSION:

An On-Site Soil Investigation Report (BAI, 8/10/2009) for residual soil contamination characterization was submitted to ACEH as requested in their directive letter dated 16 April 2009. Soil sample analytical results from a majority of the samples did not detect or detected low concentrations of petroleum hydrocarbons with the exception of the soil sample from 11 ft bgs in boring B-8, located just southeast of the station building. In their response letter dated 3 September 2009, ACEH indicated that the Site may pose a risk to human health or the environment, specifically potential contaminant volatilization to indoor air. Prior to evaluating the case for closure, ACEH indicated that this data gap must be evaluated. Therefore, a Vapor Intrusion Assessment Work Plan was submitted to ACEH on the requested due date of 26 October 2009. For reference, a Site Location Map is provided as Drawing 1 and a Site Map with Soil Gas Boring Locations is provided as Drawing 2.
