DISCUSSION:

Broadbent submitted a Site Conceptual Model and Case Closure Request during Second Quarter 2013. On September 11, 2013 Broadbent, BP and the ACEH attended a meeting to discuss the potential closure of this case. As a result, some additional Site evaluation and testing was agreed to by Broadbent and BP in order to obtain site closure. An addendum to the June 13, 2013 *Conceptual Site Model and Case Closure Request* will be submitted during the Fourth Quarter 2013.
