Dear Responsible Parties:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) staff has reviewed the case file for the subject site. Our review determined that you are out of compliance with our letter dated May 5, 2017. In our letter, ACDEH requested the submittal of all documents pertaining to investigation, remediation and monitoring (IRM) activities, including Phase I and Phase II Environment Site Assessments; soil, water, and/or soil vapor investigations; soil, water, and/or soil vapor remediation activities; and monitoring events, not currently in the case file. Our agency also requested a listing of the submittals be provided to ACDEH by electronic mail, Attention: Keith Nowell. To date no submittals of historical documents have been made to either the ACDEH FTP site or to the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCB) GeoTracker website. ACDEH requested submittal of these documents by June 6, 2017.

In our May 5, 2017 letter, ACDEH also requested the preparation and submittal of a site summary report (SSR) which documents history of site development, in addition to investigation, remediation, and monitoring activities performed at the site. The SSR was to include a determination if sufficient deterioration or sedimentation has occurred to the wells comprising the site's groundwater monitoring well network. ACDEH requested submittal of the SSR by July 22, 2017. ACDEH has no records indicating the SSR has been submitted.

Therefore, ACDEH requests that you submit the documents requested in our May 5, 2017 letter by the dates specified below.

REPORT & DELIVERABLE REQUESTS

SECTION: ACDEH Procedures

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Cleanup Oversight Programs, Local Oversight Program (LOP) and Site Cleanup Program (SCP) require submission of all reports in electronic form to the State Water Board's (SWB) GeoTracker website in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Chapter 30, Division3, Title 23 and Division 3, Title 27.

<u>Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) Cases</u>

Reports and deliverable requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party (RP) in conjunction with an unauthorized release from a petroleum underground storage tank (UST) system.

Site Cleanup Program (SCP) Cases

For non-petroleum UST cases, reports and deliverables requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 101480.

ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

A complete report submittal includes the PDF report and all associated electronic data files, including but not limited to GEO_MAP, GEO_XY, GEO_Z, GEO_BORE, GEO_WELL, and laboratory analytical data in Electronic Deliverable Format[™] (EDF). - Do not upload draft reports to GeoTracker
- Rotate each page in the PDF document in the direction that will make it easiest to read on a computer monitor.

This letter must be signed by the Responsible Party, or legally authorized representative of the Responsible Party.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION & CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

The California Business and Professions Code (Sections 6731, 6735, and 7835) requires that work plans and technical or implementation reports containing geologic or engineering evaluations and/or judgments be performed under the direction of an appropriately licensed or certified professional and include the professional registration stamp, signature, and statement of professional certification. AGENCY OVERSIGHT

Significant delays in conducting site assessment/cleanup or report submittals may result in referral of the case to the Regional Water Board or other appropriate agency, including the County District Attorney, for possible enforcement actions. California Health and Safety Code, Section 25299.76 authorizes enforcement including administrative action or monetary penalties of up to \$10,000 per day for each day of violation.
