Thank you for the recent submittals of the documents entitled *Geophysical Survey Results* (GSR), dated March 12, 2018, and *Soil and Groundwater Investigation* (SWI) dated June 26, 2018. The GSR was prepared by Amec Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure (Amecfw) and the SWI was prepared by Wood Environment & Infrastructure (Wood). Both documents were prepared for the subject case on your behalf.

The purpose of the GSR was to further refine the possible location of the former underground storage tank (UST), removed on November 28, 1988 as part of redevelopment activities for a Port of Oakland container terminal. Site redevelopment included removal of many surface features referenced for the UST location. The GSR was performed following a meeting with you and Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) staff on January 22, 2018. The SWI was performed following the April 10, 2018 conditional approval by ACDEH of the Amecfw revised work plan, dated January 29, 2018, for a soil and groundwater investigation.

ACDEH wishes to discuss the findings of the reports referenced above and to develop a path forward for closure of the subject case. We propose a meeting date and time of **1:00 PM on Tuesday, September 4, 2018** at our offices. An alternate date would be Friday September 7, 2018, also at 1:00 PM. REPORT & DELIVERABLE REQUESTS

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Cleanup Oversight Programs, Local Oversight Program (LOP) and Site Cleanup Program (SCP) require submission of all reports in electronic form to the State Water Board's (SWB) GeoTracker website in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Chapter 30, Division3, Title 23 and Division 3, Title 27.

Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) Cases

Reports and deliverable requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party (RP) in conjunction with an unauthorized release from a petroleum underground storage tank (UST) system.

Site Cleanup Program (SCP) Cases

For non-petroleum UST cases, reports and deliverables requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 101480.

ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

A complete report submittal includes the PDF report and all associated electronic data files, including but not limited to GEO_MAP, GEO_XY, GEO_Z, GEO_BORE, GEO_WELL, and laboratory analytical data in Electronic Deliverable Format[™] (EDF). California Health and Safety Code, Section 25299.76 authorizes enforcement including administrative action or monetary penalties of up to \$10,000 per day for each day of violation.
