Mr. Roberts,

This is in followup to our recent phone conversations and messages. In regards to the subject site, the City of Emeryville's has verbally requested a 6-week delay in the meeting requested by Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) in our December 31, 2012 directive letter for the referenced site. The subject site has been redeveloped and requisite documentation of site actions or cleanup has not been provided. As a result of a Low-Threat Closure Review ACEH requested the meeting with all responsible parties, including the City of Emeryville; however, as noted, the City needs to seek funds to hire a consultant and that this process will take approximately 4 to 6 weeks. The City also has stated that additional time will be required in order to contract with an appropriate environmental specialist once funds are secured internally. ACEH is in agreement with the request and in order to keep the case moving and facilitate case closure, ACEH has extended the dates, as noted below.
