Subject: Fuel Leak Case No. RO0000064 and Geotracker Global ID T0600100118, PEPSI-COLA COMPANY, 1150 PARK AVE, Emeryville CA 94608 – Groundwater Monitoring Requirements

Dear Responsible Party:

It has come to the attention of Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) that an inappropriate version of the letter regarding recent changes to groundwater monitoring requirements was sent to parties associated with this case. Please accept this letter as a retraction and correction of that letter. We are sorry for the confusion that resulted. As before, the purpose of this correspondence is to inform you of changes to groundwater monitoring requirements for all fuel leak cases in California. The California State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) has approved Resolution No. 2009-0042 (*Actions to Improve Administration of the UST Cleanup Fund and UST Cleanup Program*). Resolution No. 2009-0042 states that, "Regional Water Board and LOP agencies shall reduce quarterly groundwater monitoring requirements to semiannual or less frequent monitoring at all site unless site-specific needs warrant otherwise and shall notify all responsible parties of the new requirements no later than August 1, 2009. If more than semiannual monitoring is required for a case, the responsible party and State Water board shall be notified of the rationale and the notice shall be posted on Geotracker."

As your site does not have monitoring wells, the new groundwater monitoring requirements in State Water Board Resolution No. 2009-0042 do not affect you at this time. These new groundwater monitoring requirements potentially may apply if monitoring wells are installed at your site in the future.
