I don't think so. When I map out the address Kelly gave (3707 Bay Street; now Shellmound) it maps south of Temescal Creek about 3,770 feet to the south of the one you pointed to. My recollection is that Pfizer Pigments (formerly ACDEH case RO70 that was transferred to the DTSC in June 2011) contained case information for the area that was identified when mapped out. The case was closed by DTSC or more likely George Lockwood as the closure date in March 2016 is the last time the site was touched, and that was by George. Our former case number (RO70) is not reflected on Geotracker; it appears to have been removed by the SWB at some point (it probably should be referenced on the Facility / Site Address page of Geotracker so that Kelly or others in the future can back trace information). The Site History description is largely our writeup, but it appears George modified it a bit as his initials and date (same March 2016 date appear there at the end). We cannot modify it as it is not our site any longer, and did not retain the right to accept reports (or modify the site pages) as we did on some other cases that went to the RWQCB.

So long story short, she should look at our old RO70, now known as DTSC 01280006, with a Global Id of T0600101074.

That said the RWQCB site for 3707 Bay Street (T0600191543 and RWQCB Case 01S0437) needs to be relocated to 3707 Bay Street (mislocated by that 3,770 ft to the north of the actual site mapped address). I relocated two old closed ACDEH LOP cases from the area of the Garratt Freightliners site area just last week. I was thinking of contacting the RWQCB last week to request this, so the timing is perfect!


