This email serves to provide an update on the status of off-site property access needed to complete soil and water investigation work activities (proposed in the April 6, 2009 Work Plan and approved by the ACEH in the May 1, 2009 letter) and a second request for an extension on submittal of SWI report. Access to two off-site properties is required to complete work. Efforts to initiate verbal communication with both property owners were completed in May 2009. In June 2009 property access agreements were mailed with deliver confirmation. We have received confirmation that one of the access agreements was delivered; however, can not confirm that the other access agreement was delivered. The later agreement was sent out for a second time with delivery confirmation earlier this month.

At this point in time it does not appear necessary to request assistance with access agreement negotiations from the ACEH. However, it is not possible to meet the ACEH July 30, 2009 deadline for submittal of the soil and water investigation report, as detailed in the ACEH May 1, 2009 letter. It is therefore requested that the July 30, 2009 deadline for submittal of the report be amended to 90 days following receipt of signed property access

agreements. This is the second request for an amended deadline (the first was included in the July 21, 2009 email from myself).

If future property access agreement negotiations are unsuccessful, assistance will be requested from the ACEH. **Please provide a response to this email and our request for an extension.** If you should have questions or require additional information, please do not hesitate to contact me directly.
