We are getting ready to get in the field for the groundwater and soil vapor sampling at the above referenced site. Groundwater is between 6 and 8 feet bgs which doesn't bode well for sampling 5 feet below the potential basements in the adjacent houses. I won't want to set anything deeper than 7 feet bgs. I just wanted to give you a head's up that the SV probes will be shallower than you would like.

## Hollis,

The locations of the vapor probes are adequate, but in my judgment each could be moved 5 to 10 feet south (southwest) along the property line. This would allow SV-7 to be more protective of the residential house with the (at least) half-basement (and not as far from a probable source), and SV-8 would be more protective of vapor detected at SV-6. I am relying in part on professional judgment, so you may be aware of other information I am not in the placement of the probes. The intent is to be protective of residential use of neighboring properties.
