There was no formal agenda for the meeting. The primary topic of the meeting was the PG&E request to go through the MOA process to transfer the case to DTSC.

- PG&E has requested DTSC oversight through MOA process for this case. PG&E is not dissatisfied with ACEH oversight but they want the option to obtain clean closure for the case.
- PG&E submitted their request for MOA process but have not heard back.
- PG&E legal department want their sites to go through the more rigorous closure process with DTSC.
- Donna Drogos indicated that MOA process should be for new cases and not for transferring existing cases.
- Jerry Wickham indicated that the PG&E case should not be split from the other three cases. If DTSC takes the PG&E case, they would need to take all four cases as it does not make sense to split cases with a commingled plume.
- Next step for the four cases is to arrange a meeting with all four parties to develop a plan of action for the chlorobenzenes.
- PG&E will prepare a site history for the 5051 Coliseum Way site.
