Spoke with Bill Owens regarding what to do at the sites.

He wanted to know if he had to reexcavate the soils, since they already cemented over the areas. I told him that should never have happened; that I allowed the old soil to be backfilled ~~provided~~ until we ^{acted on the} ~~got~~ sample results. Since they've been concreted over, keep the dirt in and find out to what extent groundwater has been impacted from the soils. They are required to do an investigation on 40th Avenue.

I'm not going to take this case to the D.A. if I don't receive a work plan. There are bigger sites that can be attended to.
