Dear Mr. Hill:

This is a notice of an enforcement referral for the subject site. Site Responsible Parties are non-responsive to Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requests and are recalcitrant. The site has accumulated a series of Notice of Violations from ACEH. As a consequence, ACEH is referring this site to the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board for enforcement actions.

Three underground storage tanks (USTs), one 250-gallon and two 500-gallon tanks, were removed from the site in December, 1989. Holes were observed in both 500-gallon tanks. The tanks were reported to be used for the storage of gasoline, tetrachloroethene (PCE) and Stoddard solvent. Soil sampling associated with the tank removals found total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) up to 9,000 mg/kg and benzene to 14 mg/kg. One 3,500-gallon UST, used for the storage of Stoddard solvent, was removed in November, 2006. Soil sampling associated with the tank removal indicated total petroleum hydrocarbons as Stoddard solvent (TPHss) up to 5,550 mg/kg. Discolored soil and Stoddard odors were observed in the tank pit. Groundwater was not encountered the UST removals. There is no documentation of remedial/characterization/monitoring action at the site since November, 2006. The lateral and vertical extent of contamination is undefined.

Due to inaction to ACEH requests for site investigations following the removal of the three USTs, a Preenforcement Review Panel was held in February 1995. A workplan for soil excavation, approved in January 2007, was not implemented, and a Corrective Action Workplan due September 2007 was not submitted. There has been no response. Site Responsible Parties are non-responsive to Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requests and are recalcitrant.
