Dear Dr. Osagie and Mr. Tracy:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file for the abovereferenced site including the recently submitted document entitled, "Feasibility Study / Corrective Action Plan," dated October 27, 2009, which was prepared by Golden Gate Tank Removal, Inc. (GGTR) for the subject site. GGTR concluded that soil excavation for the shallow soil contamination with OCR application is the most cost-effective remedial alternative likely to reach cleanup objectives for the site.

The remedial alternative presented in the above-mentioned Corrective Action Plan (CAP) is acceptable provided that the technical comments presented below are incorporated into the CAP. Please note that public participation is a requirement for the CAP process. Therefore, ACEH will notify potentially affected stakeholders who live or own property in the surrounding area of the proposed remediation described in the "Corrective Action Plan" through a mailing of a fact sheet (enclosed). Public comments on the proposed remediation will be accepted for a period of thirty (30) days beginning Tuesday, February 16, 2010 through Thursday, March 18, 2010. Following the public comment period, the comments received, including ACEH's technical comments presented below, must be addressed and incorporated into a Final CAP document.

TECHNICAL COMMENTS

- <u>Laboratory Analytical Suite</u> GGTR proposes to analyze soil and groundwater samples for TPH-g, TPH-d, BTEX, and MTBE. In addition to the proposed analyses, please include lead scavengers and naphthalene.
- On-site Soil Re-use & Backfill Material GGTR states that a portion of the excavated soil
 may be suitable for backfill and is planned to be re-used at the site. According to the
 RWQCB, petroleum hydrocarbon impacted soil must be adequately characterized prior to
 reuse¹. Adequate characterization of the stockpiled soil proposed for reuse does not appear

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to have been proposed. Also, depth to water has been measured as shallow as 2 feet bgs. The RWQCB states that soil proposed for re-use onsite must be "placed at least five feet above the highest anticipated level of ground water." Since depth to water is as shallow as 2 feet bgs, the proposed soil re-use appears to violate the RWQCB soil reuse guidelines.

GGTR also plans to use class II base rock in additional to soil reuse as backfill material at the site. ACEH has concerns that backfilling the excavations with more permeable material in areas where native less-permeable soils exist may cause a preferential pathway for contaminant vapor migration from the subsurface to indoor (if a future structure is located above the former excavations) and outdoor air. Please address the above-mentioned comments and submit a revised CAP by the date specified below.

NOTIFICATION OF FIELDWORK ACTIVITIES

Please schedule and complete the fieldwork activities by the date specified below and provide ACEH with at least three (3) business days notification prior to conducting the fieldwork.

TECHNICAL REPORT REQUEST

Please submit technical reports to ACEH (Attention: Paresh Khatri), according to the following schedule:

- March 18, 2010 End of 30-day Public Participation Period
- April 19, 2010 Submit Final CAP
- **Due within 30 Days of Sampling** Quarterly Monitoring Report (2nd Quarter 2010)
- **Due within 30 Days of Sampling** Quarterly Monitoring Report (3rd Quarter 2010)
- **Due within 30 Days of Sampling** Quarterly Monitoring Report (4th Quarter 2010)
- **Due within 30 Days of Sampling** Quarterly Monitoring Report (1st Quarter 2010)

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.

ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

ACEH's Environmental Cleanup Oversight Programs (LOP and SLIC) require submission of reports in electronic form. The electronic copy replaces paper copies and is expected to be used for all public information requests, regulatory review, and compliance/enforcement activities. Instructions for submission of electronic documents to the Alameda County Environmental

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Cleanup Oversight Program FTP site are provided on the attached "Electronic Report Upload Instructions." Submission of reports to the Alameda County FTP site is an addition to existing requirements for electronic submittal of information to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) GeoTracker website. In September 2004, the SWRCB adopted regulations that require electronic submittal of information for all groundwater cleanup programs. For several years, responsible parties for cleanup of leaks from underground storage tanks (USTs) have been required to submit groundwater analytical data, surveyed locations of monitoring wells, and other data to the GeoTracker database over the Internet. Beginning July 1, 2005, these same reporting requirements were added to Spills, Leaks, Investigations, and Cleanup (SLIC) sites. Beginning July 1, 2005, electronic submittal of a complete copy of all reports for all sites is required in GeoTracker (in PDF format). Please visit the SWRCB website for more information on these requirements (http://www.swrcb.ca.gov/ust/electronic_submittal/report_rqmts.shtml.

PERJURY STATEMENT

All work plans, technical reports, or technical documents submitted to ACEH must be accompanied by a cover letter from the responsible party that states, at a minimum, the following: "I declare, under penalty of perjury, that the information and/or recommendations contained in the attached document or report is true and correct to the best of my knowledge." This letter must be signed by an officer or legally authorized representative of your company. Please include a cover letter satisfying these requirements with all future reports and technical documents submitted for this fuel leak case.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION & CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

The California Business and Professions Code (Sections 6735, 6835, and 7835.1) requires that work plans and technical or implementation reports containing geologic or engineering evaluations and/or judgments be performed under the direction of an appropriately registered or certified professional. For your submittal to be considered a valid technical report, you are to present site specific data, data interpretations, and recommendations prepared by an appropriately licensed professional and include the professional registration stamp, signature, and statement of professional certification. Please ensure all that all technical reports submitted for this fuel leak case meet this requirement.

UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND

Please note that delays in investigation, later reports, or enforcement actions may result in your becoming ineligible to receive grant money from the state's Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund (Senate Bill 2004) to reimburse you for the cost of cleanup.

AGENCY OVERSIGHT

If it appears as though significant delays are occurring or reports are not submitted as requested, we will consider referring your case to the Regional Board or other appropriate agency, including the County District Attorney, for possible enforcement actions. California Health and Safety Code, Section 25299.76 authorizes enforcement including administrative action or monetary penalties of up to \$10,000 per day for each day of violation.

Site Remediation Summary

This fact sheet has been prepared to inform community members and other interested stakeholders regarding the status of a proposed soil and groundwater cleanup at the Osagie Property (former U-haul) located 1532 Peralta Street, Oakland, California. Mr. Tracy and Dr. Osagie, the lead responsible parties for the case and their environmental consultant Golden Gate Tank Removal are proposing soil excavation and groundwater pumping as remediation technologies to cleanup the site.

Site Background

The Site is located on Peralta Street in a mixed commercial and residential neighborhood in West Oakland and is currently developed with one single story commercial structure approximately 1,175 square feet. Previous site use for automotive repair and gasoline service station has resulted in the presence of chemicals (petroleum hydrocarbons) in soil and groundwater beneath the Site.

Soil Excavation and Disposal

Soil excavation is proposed to remediate the shallow soil contamination identified at the site from the surface to twelve feet below the ground surface, using conventional earth moving equipment. Contaminated groundwater encountered in the excavation will be pumped and disposed of off-site and an Oxygen Releasing Compound (ORC) will be applied to the soils at the bottom of the excavation to promote and/or accelerate bio-attenuation. Clean segregated soil and clean backfill material would be imported as necessary to restore the desired final site grade. This method is effective because it would remove

The Alameda County Environmental Cleanup Oversight Programs (LOP and SLIC) require submission of all reports in electronic form to the county's ftp site. Paper copies of reports will no longer be accepted. The electronic copy replaces the paper copy and will be used for all public information requests, regulatory review, and compliance/enforcement activities.

REQUIREMENTS

- Entire report including cover letter must be submitted to the ftp site as a single portable document format (PDF) with no password protection. (Please do not submit reports as attachments to electronic mail.)
- It is **preferable** that reports be converted to PDF format from their original format, (e.g., Microsoft Word) rather than scanned.
- Signature pages and perjury statements **must** be included and have either original or electronic signature.
- Do not password protect the document. Once indexed and inserted into the correct electronic case file, the document will be secured in compliance with the County's current security standards and a password.
 Documents with password protection will not be accepted.
- Each page in the PDF document should be rotated in the direction that will make it easiest to read on a computer monitor.
- Reports must be named and saved using the following naming convention:
 - RO#_Report Name_Year-Month-Date (e.g., RO#5555_WorkPlan_2005-06-14)

Additional Recommendations

• A separate copy of the tables in the document should be submitted by e-mail to your Caseworker in **Excel** format. These are for use by assigned Caseworker only.

Submission Instructions
