There are occasionally hiccups if it's uploaded after 5 or 6 pm due to daily system recovery / saving operations.

In regards to the extension, that does sound like a plan. Please use this to document ACEH concurrence with the extension request to December 31. You should know that the city of Oakland generally does not permit public encroachment into public right of ways between Nov 1 and Jan 2 (or thereabouts) due to the holidays.

Hi Mark,

ARCADIS submitted the 1<sup>st</sup> Semi-Annual Groundwater Monitoring report on August 14, 2014 to Alameda County and. I know this has been uploaded to both Alameda County Sharepoint site and to GeoTracker, but for some reason we cannot locate it in either location. The report was also federal expressed to you. Therefore, we uploaded another copy today to GeoTracker. I am writing to make sure you've received it and I am attaching another copy for your convenience.


Also, we are still having issues obtaining site access to the private property (Mills College) across Seminary Avenue from the site and with the City of Oakland to obtain permits for the installation of the off-site monitoring well. You have granted us an extension for October 30, 2014 to submit the report. However, given the issues with the City, we will not meet this deadline. I know from our previous conversations, you've stated that you will continue to work with us regarding this issue and grant extensions in 2 month increments. Therefore, we will need to request another extension for the report submittal.

ARCADIS will continue to work with the site owners and with the City to obtain the necessary permits to proceed with the site investigation. I will keep you updated on any progress we make.
