On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC), ARCADIS U.S., Inc. (ARCADIS) is submitting this report summarizing the activities related to the destruction of the wells at the former Chevron Service Station No. 9-9708, located in Oakland, California (Site; Figure 1), which consisted of six groundwater monitoring wells (Figure 2). Well destruction activities were conducted in accordance with the Alameda County Environmental Health Agency's (ACEHA's) *Notification of End of Public Participation and Request for Well Destruction* letter dated February 27, 2015 (Attachment A). Field activities were completed in accordance with the Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA) Water Resources Well Permits W2015-0212 through W2015-0217 (Attachment B) under the supervision of ARCADIS staff.

#### **Background**

The site is currently an active Valero branded service station located at 5910 MacArthur Boulevard in Oakland, California (Figure 1) on the southeast corner of MacArthur Boulevard and Seminary Avenue. The site is bounded to the southeast by a mixed first-story commercial and second-story residential building which shares an open parking lot, and to the east by a two-story residential apartment building. A vacant lot and commercial businesses are located west of the site across MacArthur Boulevard. Mills College is located to the north-northwest of the site across Seminary Avenue.

Current site features include a convenience store, three gasoline USTs, and two dispenser islands with associated canopies (Figure 2). With the exception of the

commercial building, signage, and landscaping, the site is paved with asphalt or concrete for parking. There are no current plans to redevelop the site, and it is expected to remain an active service station in the future.

#### **Permitting**

As mentioned above, ARCADIS obtained a well destruction permit for the groundwater monitoring wells (Table 1) from ACPWA (Attachment B). In addition, excavation and obstruction permits were obtained from the City of Oakland for offsite monitoring wells MW-4 through MW-6 (Attachment C).

#### **Pre-field Activities**

As required by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) 29 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 1910.120 (Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Responses), ARCADIS updated the site-specific Health and Safety Plan to address the health and safety issues related to the field activities conducted at the Site.

The ACEHA was notified at least 72 hours prior to commencement of field activities (Attachment A). In addition, Underground Service Alert (USA) of Northern California was contacted to notify companies with public utilities in the area of the upcoming field activities.

#### **Field Activities**

On April 20, 2015, Ground Penetrating Radar Systems, Inc., a private utility locating company, under the supervision of ARCADIS staff, conducted a survey of utilities in the vicinity of the wells to be destroyed.

On May 4, 2015, Cascade Drilling, Inc. (Cascade Drilling), under the supervision of ARCADIS staff, completed the well destructions. Well lids and rings were removed with hand tools prior to destruction, with the exception of monitoring well MW-4, where the well lid and ring were left in place until surface restoration could take place the following week. The approximate locations of the six destroyed wells are shown on Figure 2. The wells were destroyed by pressure grouting methods. The casing was filled with neat Portland cement with bentonite and 5 percent cement mixture from bottom to top using tremie methods. Then a grout manifold was attached to the casing and pressure was applied to the well casing for approximately 5 minutes. The

average pressure observed during pressure grouting was approximately 25 pounds per square inch (psi). The upper portion of polyvinyl chloride (PVC) casing extending to the bottom of each well box was then removed from the subsurface after grouting was completed. After pressure grouting and casing removal were performed, approximately 0.5 foot of concrete was placed in the former locations of the onsite wells (MW-1 through MW-3), flush with the ground surface. On May 6, 2015, the locations of offsite wells MW-5 and MW-6 were paved back with hot-patch asphalt to match existing conditions (approximately 4 inches of asphalt). On May 12, 2015 the well box for offsite well MW-4 was removed, and the concrete surrounding the well was restored.

#### **Waste Disposal**

No regulated waste was generated during the well destruction process. Clean concrete debris, well casings, and well box debris were properly disposed of by Cascade Drilling as commercial waste.

#### Closing

ARCADIS is submitting this report to document the destruction of wells at the Site. The well destruction activities were conducted in accordance with the ACEHA directive letter and applicable permits. Cascade Drilling will complete and submit the DWR 188 Well Completion Forms for the destroyed wells.



#### **Specific Work Permit Conditions**

- 1. Drilling Permit(s) can be voided/ cancelled only in writing. It is the applicant's responsibility to notify Alameda County Public Works Agency, Water Resources Section in writing for an extension or to cancel the drilling permit application. No drilling permit application(s) shall be extended beyond ninety (90) days from the original start date. Applicants may not cancel a drilling permit application after the completion date of the permit issued has passed.
- 2. Prior to any drilling activities, it shall be the applicant's responsibility to contact and coordinate an Underground Service Alert (USA), obtain encroachment permit(s), excavation permit(s) or any other permits or agreements required for that Federal, State, County or City, and follow all City or County Ordinances. No work shall begin until all the permits and requirements have been approved or obtained. It shall also be the applicants responsibilities to provide to the Cities or to Alameda County an Traffic Safety Plan for any lane closures or detours planned. No work shall begin until all the

permits and requirements have been approved or obtained.

- 3. Compliance with the well-sealing specifications shall not exempt the well-sealing contractor from complying with appropriate State reporting-requirements related to well construction or destruction (Sections 13750 through 13755 (Division 7, Chapter 10, Article 3) of the California Water Code). Contractor must complete State DWR Form 188 and mail original to the Alameda County Public Works Agency, Water Resources Section, within 60 days. Include permit number and site map.
- 4. Applicant shall submit the copies of the approved encroachment permit to this office within 10 days.
- 5. Permittee shall assume entire responsibility for all activities and uses under this permit and shall indemnify, defend and save the Alameda County Public Works Agency, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any and all expense, cost and liability in connection with or resulting from the exercise of this Permit including, but not limited to, property damage, personal injury and wrongful death.
- 6. Applicant shall contact assigned inspector listed on the top of the permit at least five (5) working days prior to starting, once the permit has been approved. Confirm the scheduled date(s) at least 24 hours prior to drilling.
- 7. Permittee, permittee's contractors, consultants or agents shall be responsible to assure that all material or waters generated during drilling, boring destruction, and/or other activities associated with this Permit will be safely handled, properly managed, and disposed of according to all applicable federal, state, and local statutes regulating such. In no case shall these materials and/or waters be allowed to enter, or potentially enter, on or off-site storm sewers, dry wells, or waterways or be allowed to move off the property where work is being completed.
- 8. Remove the Christy box or similar structure.

Destroy well by grouting neat cement with a tremie pipe or pressure grouting (25 psi for 5min.) to the bottom of the well and by filling with neat cement to three (3-5) feet below surface grade. Allow the sealing material to spill over the top of the casing to fill any annular space between casing and soil.

After the seal has set, backfill the remaining hole with concrete or compacted material to match existing conditions.

- 9. Remove the Christy box or similar structure. Pressure Grout with Cement (Less than 30 ft in depth). After the seal has set, backfill the remaining hole with concrete or compacted material to match existing.
- 10. Copy of approved drilling permit must be on site at all times. Failure to present or show proof of the approved permit application on site shall result in a fine of \$500.00.
