Hello Mr. Sappal:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file, including the June 24, 2014 *Groundwater Monitoring and Sampling Results Report Spring 2014* prepared on your behalf by Stratus Environmental, Inc. (Stratus). The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted the Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP) in August 2012 for the purpose of establishing consistent statewide case closure criteria for low-threat petroleum Underground Storage Tank (UST) sites.

We would like to set up a meeting with you at our office to discuss a review of the site's status in comparison with the LTCP and to develop a path to closure for your case. Please send me by July 18, 2014 three dates and times in July, August, or September that you and your consultant would be available to meet with us. ACEH staff will coordinate selection of a meeting date and time from your list to arrange the meeting.
