On behalf of Douglas Parking Company, Pangea Environmental Services, Inc. has prepared this *Addendum* to the *Revised Data Gap Workplan* as requested by your email dated October 16, 2013.

Confirmation Boring CB-2

After inspecting the site and reviewing figures of prior sampling and excavation extents, Pangea intends to install one confirmation soil boring (CB-2) between former excavation compliance samples T1 and SW2 instead of installing a third boring (CB-3) near former soil sample SW2 (Figure 1). The installation of a third boring (CB-3) was requested by the Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) letter dated September 13, 2013. As depicted on the attached figure, installing two confirmation borings outside the limits of the former excavation (per County request) would result in two borings installed within 5 ft of each other. Additionally, Pangea intends to control project costs by installing boring CB-2 within the well box of well AS-1 or AS-2 to avoid sidewalk flag replacement within the site driveway.


