Hi Barb,

As we discussed on the phone today, we have a number of concerns regarding whether we will be able to complete field work by January 15. First, I am concerned that we may not be able to get permits in place (particularly the encroachment permit considering the December holiday slowdown). Second, weather might become an issue during the vapor sampling phase; we have to have at least 5 clear days after a rain event of 0.5 inches for the vapor sampling. We had hoped to do the vapor sampling at the same time as the site investigation, but in the midst of the rainy season that is likely overly optimistic. Third, we have to arrange with the resident at the site for access, which has to coincide with our field personnel's schedule.

When we have a good idea of when we will be able to have the encroachment permit complete and the other scheduling issues settled, I'll send you the follow up email we discussed so that you can update your 101 electronic fields re the estimated date of fieldwork completion.
