On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron), Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) submits this letter for scope of work update for former Chevron-branded service station 90517, which was located at 3900 Piedmont Avenue, Oakland, Alameda County, California (the Site). As discussed during our telephone conversation on February 7, 2016, after meeting with the new tenant and evaluating the new building layout, the exterior vapor probes proposed in our initial work plan will be eliminated. Stantec will proceed with sub-slab vapor probe installations and sampling, including the addition of sub-slab probe SS-4 and corresponding indoor/outdoor air sampling according to the adjusted locations. Soil boring B-5 will also be eliminated due to conflict with the ADA accessible parking space and ramp. Please see the attached figure for adjusted locations.

Stantec will provide additional updates to ACEH should we encounter additional delays.
