On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC), Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) respectfully requests an extension to prepare the Data Gap Work Plan and upload XYZ survey data to Geotracker for the former Chevron-branded service station 90517, which was located at 3900 Piedmont Avenue, Oakland, Alameda County, California (the Site).

In a letter dated October 10, 2017, Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) requested preparation of a Data Gap Work Plan (Work Plan). The ACDEH letter was prepared in response to the *Site Assessment Report and Request for Closure* submitted on August 11, 2017.

The ACDEH letter directed that the Data Gap Work Plan be submitted by December 22, 2017. As State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) staff are directed to automatically review an underground storage tank (UST) case closure denial within 6 months of the date of the denial by the Local Oversight Program (i.e., ACDEH), CEMC respectfully requests that the due date for the Data Gap Work Plan be extended to 60 days after receipt of a determination from SWRCB.

Stantec is in the process of contracting to obtain survey data for the site and is expected to be able to upload the XYZ data by February 16, 2018.
