Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) has prepared this *Work Plan Addendum* for the site referenced above on behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron). CRA previously prepared and submitted to Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) the July 16, 2009 *Work Plan for Additional Site Investigation* (work plan), that proposed additional investigation at the site we anticipated would be necessary to move the site toward case closure. The proposed investigation included the drilling of two additional downgradient exploratory borings in the vicinity of previous boring SB-2 to further evaluate the offsite extent of impacted groundwater, and the installation and sampling of three soil vapor wells onsite to evaluate potential vapor intrusion concerns. However, upon further review of the site conditions and the results of the previous investigation, we propose to move the two exploratory borings further downgradient to increase the likelihood plume definition can be achieved, as further described below.

To avoid potential delays due to access issues with private property owners, CRA proposes to move the two exploratory borings further downgradient to Howe Street, as shown on the attached Figure 2. All other details and procedures outlined in the July 16, 2009 work plan remain in place and will be followed during the investigation.


