Hello Mr. Shirar:

ACEH staff has reviewed the case file, including the February 7, 2012 Correspondence prepared on your behalf by ACC Environmental sent in response to my December 28, 2011 Directive Letter. Since these correspondences were exchanged, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted the *Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy* (LTCP) in August 2012 for the purpose of establishing consistent statewide case closure criteria for low-threat petroleum Underground Storage Tank (UST) sites. In July, we would like to set up a meeting with you at our office to discuss a review of the site's status in comparison with the LTCP and to develop a path to closure for your case. Please send me three dates and times that you and your consultant would be available to meet with us.
