Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) is submitting this *Well Destruction Report* for the site referenced above (Figure 1) on behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (EMC). As the final step for case closure, in accordance with the Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) correspondences dated May 23, 2014, August 4, 2014 and September 22, 2014 (Attachment A), remaining monitoring wells MW-9, MW-13, MW-15, MW-16, and MW-17 were destroyed as described below.

# 1.0 Well Destruction Activities

# Permits

Well destruction was performed in general accordance with Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA) water resources well permits W2014-0789 through MW2014-0793, dated August 26, 2014; and City of Oakland traffic control plan permit TSD-14-0168, obstruction permits OB1400815 and OB1400816, and excavation permits X1402411, X1402413, and X1402414. Copies of all permits are included as Attachment B.

# Site Health and Safety Plan

CRA prepared a site specific health and safety plan (HASP) to protect site workers and visitors during the well destruction activities. The HASP was kept onsite, and reviewed, signed, and followed by site workers and visitors.

# **Underground Utility Location**

CRA marked the site for Underground Service Alert (USA) clearance and notified USA prior to beginning work. On October 29 and 30, 2014, private underground utility locator, NORCAL Geophysical Consultants Inc., of Cotati, California, was contracted to identify subsurface utilities and obstructions near the wells and to confirm markings by USA.

# Well Destruction

On October 29 and 30, 2014, CRA staff observed Vapor Tech Services (C-57 License No. 916085) destroy wells MW-9, MW-13, MW-15, MW-16, and MW-17 (Figure 2). As permitted by ACPWA, the wells were destroyed by pressure grouting. Pressure grouting was completed by injecting neat Portland Type II/V cement through a tremie pipe to the wells total depth. A pressure of at least 25 pounds per square inch was then applied to the well casing for at least 5 minutes. Due to the City of Oakland moratorium of work on city right-of-way from November 1, 2014 through January 1, 2015, the well boxes were not removed. The well boxes will be removed and backfilled with asphalt and roadbase to match existing surface grade once the moratorium has lifted. CRA's *Standard Field Procedures for Monitoring Well Destruction* is presented as Attachment C.

# Well Completion Reports

On November 12, 2014, CRA submitted the Well Completion Reports to the Department of Water Resources (DWR) and ACPWA under a separate cover. The DWR Well Completion Reports are confidential documents and are not included in this report. Copies are maintained in our files and can be provided upon written request.

# Waste Removal

No waste was generated during well destruction activities. Construction debris expected during well box removal will be transported to an appropriate disposal facility.







Dear Ms. Fischer and Mr. Small:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file including the *Site Conceptual Model and Low-Threat Closure Request,* dated March 28, 2014. The report was generated and submitted on your behalf by Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA). Thank you for submitting the report. As you are aware, numerous site investigations and groundwater monitoring events for underground storage tank leaks have been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. ACEH is in general agreement that the subject fuel case is suitable for potential case closure under the State Water Resource Control (SWRCB) Board Low-Threat Closure Policy.

#### List of Landowners Form

Pursuant to Section 25297.15 (a), Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH), the local agency, shall not consider cleanup or site closure proposals from the primary or active responsible party, issue a closure letter, or make a determination that no further action is required with respect to a site upon which there was an unauthorized release of hazardous substances from an underground storage tank subject to this chapter unless all current record owners of fee title to the site of the proposed action have been notified of the proposed action by the primary or active responsible party. ACEH is required to notify the primary or active responsible party of their requirement to certify in writing to the local agency that the notification requirement in the above-mentioned regulation has been satisfied and to provide the local agency with a complete mailing list of all record fee title owners.

To satisfy this requirement, please complete the enclosed *List of Landowners Form*, and mail or e-mail it back to ACEH by the date identified below. Also your comments, if any, must be considered prior to the proposed closure. Please respond within 30 days from the date of this letter for your comments to be considered.

#### **Public Participation**

Public participation is a requirement for the case closure process. In order to notify potentially affected members of the public of the potential fuel leak case closure, ACEH will distribute the attached *Notification of Potential Case Closure* to addresses in the immediate vicinity. The *Invitation to Comment - Potential Case Closure* requests that landowners or residents submit any comments or questions to

ACEH regarding the potential case closure by August 1, 2014. ACEH will consider all comments from the public prior to potential case closure. ACEH will provide written notification if any comments are received.

#### Request for Monitoring Well Destruction Scheduling and Waste Removal

Local Oversight Programs are required by the State's Low Threat Closure Policy (LTCP) to issue a uniform closure letter within 30 days from the end of the public comment period and completion of associated tasks (report of monitoring well destruction and waste removal) for case closures. After written ACEH concurrence (e-mail or other) that there have been no comments, and provided ACEH receives the required List of Landowners Form as is described above, you would be free to proceed with well decommissioning and waste removal activities.

In order to meet this timeline ACEH requests that wells be scheduled for destruction, wastes (as defined by the LTCP) be removed from the site, and a Well Decommissioning Report and appropriate disposal documentation submitted as soon as possible after the end date of the public comment period. Please contact the Alameda County Public Works Agency at 510-567-6791 or online, to obtain the required well destruction permits. Please provide notification to ACEH of the date of planned well destruction and waste removal activities.

#### REPORT REQUESTS

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.

#### ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

ACEH's Environmental Cleanup Oversight Programs (LOP and SLIC) require submission of reports in electronic form. The electronic copy replaces paper copies and is expected to be used for all public information requests, regulatory review, and compliance/enforcement activities. Instructions for submission of electronic documents to the Alameda County Environmental Cleanup Oversight Program FTP site are provided on the attached "Electronic Report Upload Instructions." Submission of reports to the Alameda County FTP site is an addition to existing requirements for electronic submittal of information to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) GeoTracker website. In September 2004, the SWRCB adopted regulations that require electronic submittal of information for all groundwater cleanup programs. For several years, responsible parties for cleanup of leaks from underground storage tanks (USTs) have been required to submit groundwater analytical data, surveyed locations of monitoring wells, and other data to the GeoTracker database over the Internet. Beginning July 1, 2005, these same reporting requirements were added to Spills, Leaks, Investigations, and Cleanup (SLIC) sites. Beginning July 1, 2005, electronic submittal of a complete copy of all reports for all sites is required in GeoTracker (in PDF format). the SWRCB website for more information on these requirements Please visit (http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/water issues/programs/ust/electronic submittal/).

#### PERJURY STATEMENT

All work plans, technical reports, or technical documents submitted to ACEH must be accompanied by a cover letter from the responsible party that states, at a minimum, the following: "I declare, under penalty of perjury, that the information and/or recommendations contained in the attached document or report is true and correct to the best of my knowledge." This letter must be signed by an officer or legally authorized representative of your company. Please include a cover letter satisfying these requirements with all future reports and technical documents submitted for this fuel leak case.

#### PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION & CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

The California Business and Professions Code (Sections 6735, 6835, and 7835.1) requires that work plans and technical or implementation reports containing geologic or engineering evaluations and/or judgments be performed under the direction of an appropriately registered or certified professional. For your submittal to be considered a valid technical report, you are to present site specific data, data interpretations, and recommendations prepared by an appropriately licensed professional and include the professional registration stamp, signature, and statement of professional certification. Please ensure all that all technical reports submitted for this fuel leak case meet this requirement.

#### UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND

Please note that delays in investigation, later reports, or enforcement actions may result in your becoming ineligible to receive grant money from the state's Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund (Senate Bill 2004) to reimburse you for the cost of cleanup.

#### AGENCY OVERSIGHT

If it appears as though significant delays are occurring or reports are not submitted as requested, we will consider referring your case to the Regional Board or other appropriate agency, including the County District Attorney, for possible enforcement actions. California Health and Safety Code, Section 25299.76 authorizes enforcement including administrative action or monetary penalties of up to \$10,000 per day for each day of violation.

As you are likely aware, the public comment period for the subject site ended on Friday August 1, 2014. I have had a chance to review my emails and phone messages that I received while on vacation, and no written or verbal comments were received by Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH). Therefore, Chevron is free to proceed with the destruction of all wells associated with the site (groundwater, vapor, etc), as requested in the May 23, 2014 letter from ACEH. The timelines established in that letter should be adequate to complete the tasks; however, if additional time is required, please let me know.

Conestoga-Rovers and Associates (CRA) on behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (EMC) would like to request an extension for the October 3 , 2014 date that Alameda County Environmental Health's (ACEH) requested for the Monitoring Well Decommissioning and Waste Removal in ACEH letter dated May 23, 2014 and email dated August 4, 2014. The reason for the extension, as discussed over the phone on September 19, 2014, is that the City of Oakland has no record of an encroachment permit for monitoring wells MW-9 and MW-13. The City of Oakland is requiring that a new encroachment permit be obtained for monitoring wells MW-9 and MW-13 before the wells can be destroyed. Based on recent experiences with the City of Oakland, the encroachment permit can take anywhere from 3 to over 6 months to obtain. Also the City of Oakland has a moratorium for any work in the area from November 1, 2014 to January 2, 2015. Therefore an extension of **January 16, 2014** for the Monitoring Well Decommissioning and Waste Removal is requested. Based on this new extension date, the Well Decommissioning Report would be submitted 60 days after the wells have been destroyed. Attention is directed to Section 7-10. Public Convenience and Safety, of the City of Oakland Standard Specification for Public Works Construction, 2006 Edition (Include this paragraph for p-jobs, excavation permits or obstruction permits).

The Contractor shall conduct its work in such a manner as to provide public convenience and safety and according to the provisions in this subsection. The provisions shall not be modified or altered without written approval from the Engineer.

# CRA'S STANDARD FIELD PROCEDURES FOR WELL DESTRUCTIONS

# STANDARD FIELD PROCEDURES FOR MONITORING WELL DESTRUCTION

This document presents standard field procedures for properly destroying groundwater monitoring wells. The objective of well destruction is to destroy wells in a manner that is protective of potential water resources. The two procedures most commonly used are pressure grouting and drilling out the well. These procedures are designed to comply with Federal, State and local regulatory guidelines. Specific field procedures are summarized below.

# Pressure Grouting

Pressure grouting consists of injecting neat Portland cement through a tremie pipe under pressure to the bottom of the well. The cement is composed of about five gallons of water to a 94 pound sack of Portland II/V Cement. Once the well casing is full of grout, it is pressurized for five minutes by applying a pressure of 25 pounds per square inch (psi) with a grout pump. The well casing can also be pressurized by extending the well casing to the appropriate height and filling it with grout. In either case, the additional pressure allows the grout to be forced into the sand pack. After grouting the sand pack and casing, the well vault is removed and the area resurfaced or backfilled as required.

# Well Drill Out

When well drill out is required, the well location is cleared for subsurface utilities and a hollow-stem auger (or other appropriate) drilling rig is used to drill out the well casing and filter pack materials. First, drill rods are placed down the well and used to guide the augers as they drill out the well. A guide auger is used in place of the drill rods if feasible. Once the well is drilled out, the boring is filled with Portland cement injected through the augers or a tremmie pipe under pressure to the bottom of the boring. The well vault is removed and the area resurfaced or backfilled as required.

# Waste Handling and Disposal

Soil cuttings from drilling activities are usually stockpiled onsite and covered by plastic sheeting. At least three individual soil samples are collected from the stockpiles and composited at the analytic laboratory. The composite sample is analyzed for the same constituents analyzed in the borehole samples in addition to any analytes required by the receiving disposal facility. Soil cuttings are transported by licensed waste haulers and disposed in secure, licensed facilities based on the composite analytic results.
