Dear Mr. Pankratz:

Under the direction of this office, Shell Oil Products US is conducting an environmental investigation for a property located at 2703 Martin Luther King, Jr. Way in Oakland. A fuel leak from a former service station at 2703 Martin Luther King, Jr. Way has resulted in soil and groundwater contamination in the area of the site. The extent of the soil and groundwater contamination is not fully defined but may extend to your property at 668 27<sup>th</sup> Street.

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) is requiring Shell Oil Products US to characterize the extent of contamination from their site. In order to do this, soil sampling has been proposed on your property at 668 27<sup>th</sup> Street. We understand that Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (on behalf of Shell Oil Products US) sent you a Request for Access. We understand that no agreement has been completed to date and request that you resolve this access agreement promptly and reasonably in order to define the extent of contamination. It is important to complete the investigation as part of the current fuel leak case. By not allowing the investigation to be completed under the current fuel leak case, you may be retaining some future liability for any contamination that may exist beneath your property.

ACEH requests you complete negotiations with Conestoga-Rovers & Associates, on behalf of Shell Oil Products US, by January 9, 2013. This request is made pursuant to Water Code Section 13267, which allows ACEH to require technical reports from persons whose activities may have an impact on water quality.
