Cambria Environmental Technology, Inc. (Cambria) prepared this submittal on behalf of Equilon Enterprises LLC dba Shell Oil Products US (Shell). In correspondence dated December 29, 2005, the Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requested submittal of the results of the door-to-door survey by January 10, 2006, and a status of access agreements and schedule for off-site investigation update by January 20, 2006. In electronic correspondence dated January 5, 2006, Cambria requested an extension for submittal of the door-to-door survey results to January 20, 2006, for inclusion with the other information. The ACEH approved the extension in electronic correspondence dated January 5, 2006.

## **SITE LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION**

The site is a former service station located on the northwest corner of Martin Luther King Jr. Way and 27<sup>th</sup> Street in a commercial and residential area of Oakland, California (Figure 1). The site layout consisted of a service station building, two dispenser islands, three underground fuel storage tanks (USTs), associated product piping, and a waste oil UST (Figure 2). Until recently, the station building was used as a repair shop and with two service bays. Currently, the site is used for storage and some auto repair work by the property owner.

## **DOOR TO DOOR SURVEY RESULTS**

In the *Site Investigation Report* dated November 15, 2005, Cambria recommended performing a door-to-door survey within 300-feet of the subject site to for wells, basements, and foundation type to identify building construction and potential vapor receptors. The survey questionnaire also included questions regarding buried underground storage tanks and private wells to assist

with identification of other potential sources and groundwater receptors. Questionnaires were sent to 110 properties and responses for 25 properties were received as of January 13, 2006. Table 1 summarizes the responses received. A list of properties included in the survey and the completed surveys received are included in Appendix A.

Of the 25 responses received, none of the properties had basements. Three properties were denoted as vacant; nine properties contained buildings constructed with slab-on-grade foundations; three contained buildings constructed with perimeter foundations. Responses for the other 10 properties were either left blank, marked as unknown, or the response was contradictory or unclear. Regarding underground storage tanks, 17 responses were negative, four responses were marked as “unknown”, and four responses were left blank. With the exception of the monitoring wells at the subject site, no wells were identified through the survey activities.



## **STATUS OF ONSITE INVESTIGATION ACTIVITIES**

Based on the scopes of work presented in the *Feasibility Study Work Plan* dated November 22, 2005, and the *Plume Delineation Work Plan* dated December 20, 2005, Cambria has completed a number of the proposed activities:

- A batch groundwater extraction event occurred on December 13, 2005. The results are presented herein.
- Onsite soil boring, SB-23, was installed and sampled the first week of January 2006.
- Onsite wells MW-6, MW-7, and MW-8 were installed the first week of January. Although this site was scheduled to be monitored during the second month of the quarter (February), in order to sample the groundwater conditions prior to the DPE test, the wells were developed and sampled the second week of January 2006;
- Onsite soil vapor probes (VP-1 through VP-6) were drilled but not installed due to significant rainfall and saturated soil conditions the first week of January. They were backfilled with clean sand and the protective well boxes were installed at the surface. Because of this, there will be no data from soil vapor sampling to report by February 15, 2006, as requested by the ACEH in correspondence dated December 29, 2005. These activities were discussed with, and approved by, ACEH during the field activities on January 3, 2006. The schedule for the installation of the probes is presented below.
- DPE Pilot testing is occurring the week of January 16, 2006.

access agreement is executed for this property, Cambria will be able to conduct an inspection of the crawl space.

## **PROPOSED SCHEDULE**

***Vapor Probe Installations:*** Because it is the rainy season, and conditions need to be relatively dry to successfully install and sample soil vapor probes, an exact date for installation of the six onsite probes has not been set. However, Cambria will make every effort to install the six onsite vapor probes, and the offsite vapor probe at 670 27<sup>th</sup> Street (VP-12) by the end of February 2006. Sampling of the probes would be attempted in March, also depending on weather.


***Offsite Monitoring Well Installations:*** As of the date of this document, Cambria has scheduled the installation of offsite wells MW-9, MW-10, MW-11, MW-14, and MW-15 for February 27 and 28, 2006. Because of the limited access and site conditions, the small “Rhino” rig was needed for this work, and these were the next available dates for that equipment. Encroachment permitting, boring/well permitting, and traffic control plans will be obtained, as necessary.

***Document Submittals:*** If there are no delays and the above-referenced work is completed by February 28, 2006, a report of the field activities will be submitted by May 15, 2006.



**Document Submittals:** As requested by the ACEH, documentation of the onsite soil and groundwater investigation and the DPE feasibility study is scheduled for submittal by March 15, 2006. As requested by the ACEH, the results of the first quarter groundwater monitoring event will be submitted by April 15, 2006.

## RESULTS OF GWE EVENT



In an attempt to perform contaminant mass removal from the groundwater at this site, a batch groundwater extraction (GWE) event was performed on wells MW-4, MW-5, and V-2 over a period of 6 hours on December 13, 2005. An approximate total of less than 230 gallons of water was extracted during this period, with most of the water produced from well MW-5, since MW-4 and V-2 de-watered. Approximately 0.25 feet of drawdown was observed in well V-1 throughout the purging event of the other three wells. Given the low volume extracted (and therefore low mass removed), no additional events were scheduled. The water was reclaimed at Shell's Martinez Refinery. Cambria's field notes and the vacuum truck purge sheet for this event are included in Appendix B.

## STATUS OF ACCESS AGREEMENTS FOR OFFSITE INVESTIGATION

A number of vapor probe and monitoring well locations were proposed at offsite locations. Access to a total of seven offsite private properties has been requested by Shell. As of January 13, 2006, two executed access agreements have been received (670 27<sup>th</sup> Street [VP-12 and MW-14] and 2727-2729 Martin Luther King Jr. Way [MW-15]). Cambria was contacted by the property owner of 664 27<sup>th</sup> Street (immediately adjacent to the eastern property boundary of the subject site) and described the proposed activities and rationale to the property owner; however, an executed access agreement has not been received. The remaining four properties remain unresponsive to the initial request for access (668 27<sup>th</sup> Street, 665 28<sup>th</sup> Street, 669 28<sup>th</sup> Street, and 673 28<sup>th</sup> Street). A second request for access will be transmitted to each of the five property owners where access agreements have not been executed.

**Foundation Construction at 664 27<sup>th</sup> Street:** During the afore-mentioned conversation with the property owner regarding access, Cambria asked about the building construction. According to the property owner, the structure is constructed on a pier and post foundation which is over five-feet above grade, and only the single-car garage is constructed with a slab-on-grade foundation. A photograph of this residence is included in Appendix C, for reference; however, additional information is needed about the construction and use of the crawl space at this location. Once an

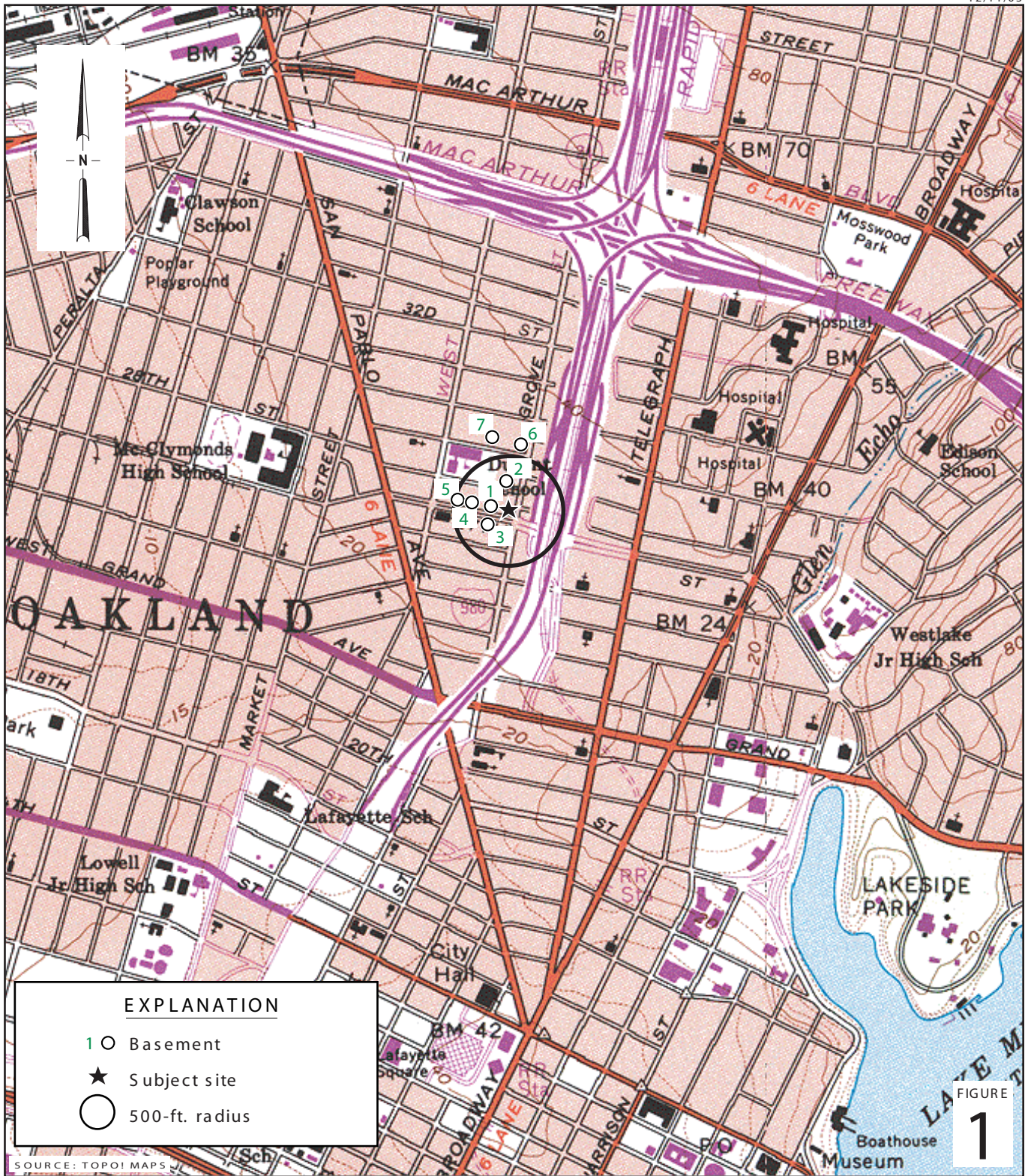

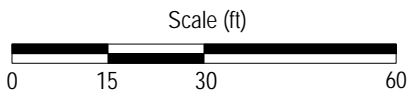
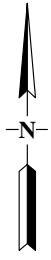

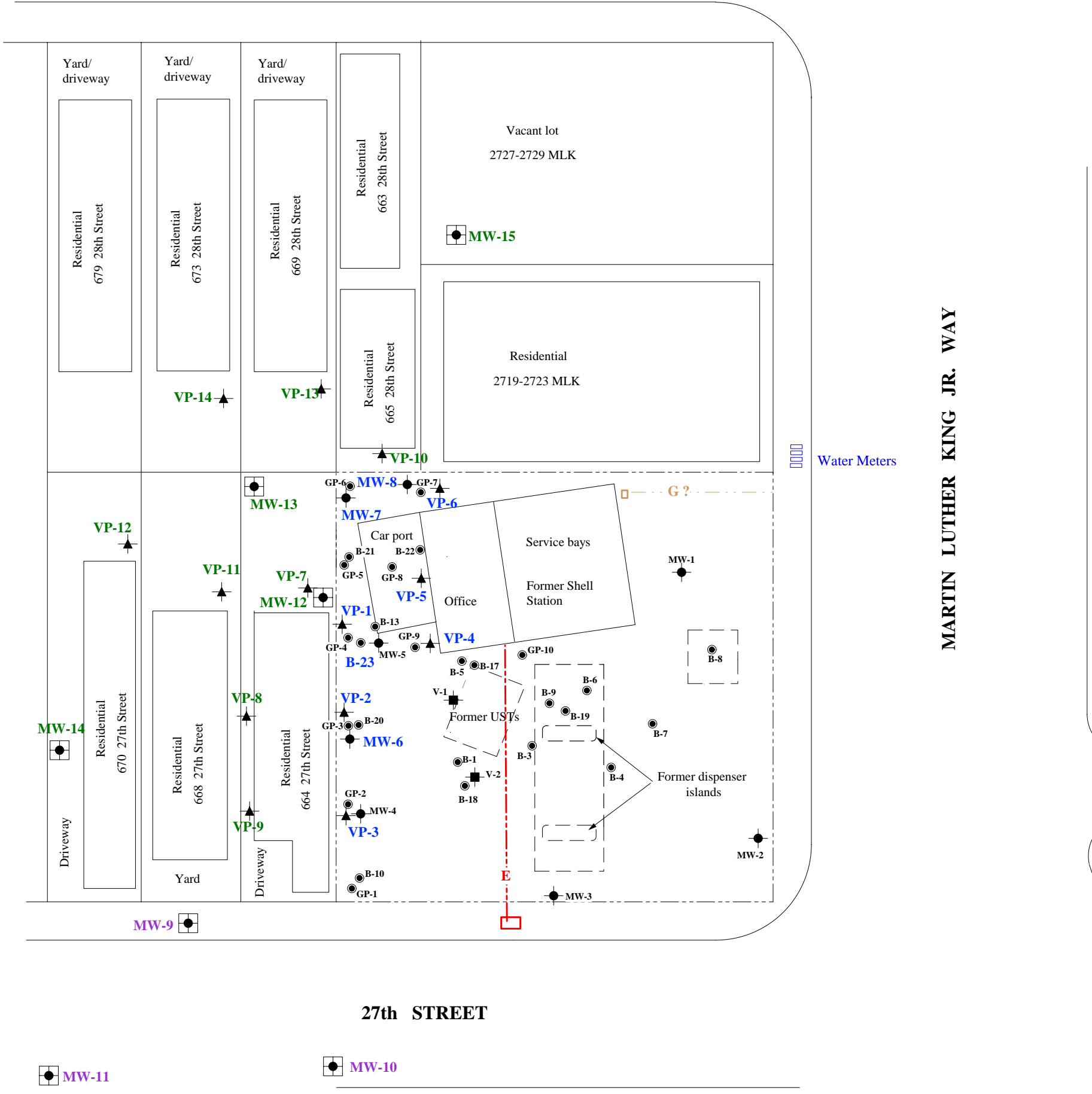
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**Site Vicinity/Receptor
