Hi Barbara,

This e-mail documents the conversation we had on 2/19/13 regarding the above referenced site.

You are requesting semi-annual groundwater sampling commencing this April 2013. Following receipt of the sampling results we will evaluate the data using the State's guidelines for low risk closure.

In addition, you are requesting a limited "Phase I study" in an attempt to locate the four old water-supply wells identified by the Department of Water Resources (DWR). The DWR had no additional information regarding well locations. The study should include (as available); review of historic USGS and Sanborn Maps, and available air photos. You mentioned that one well location is shown on a USGS map in your office. Any well locations found will be confirmed with a field reconnaissance. As mentioned during our conversation, the College is not aware of any water-supply wells located on the campus.

Please confirm that the above summarizes the current regulatory directive for the site.
