The public comment period for the subject site ended on October 24, 2014. No comments were received by Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH).

You are free to proceed with the destruction of all wells associated with the site (groundwater, vapor, etc.), as requested in the attached September 19, 2014 letter from ACEH. As requested in the letter, please contact the Alameda County Public Works Agency to obtain well destruction permits. Following the well destruction, please provide ACEH a well destruction report according to the schedule outlined below. The well destruction report should document site activities, provide well destruction permit documentation, and documentation indicating that any remaining investigation, remediation, and well destruction derived waste have been removed from the site

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.
