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**Responsible Party Identification Background**

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R. Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

### Responsible Party Identification

#### Existence of Unauthorized Release

On December 15, 1992, one 500-gallon, one 1,000-gallon steel gasoline, and one 250-gallon waste oil underground storage tanks (USTs) were removed from the site. Concentrations up to 290 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH) as gasoline and 0.14 mg/kg benzene were detected in soil. These data indicate that an unauthorized release had occurred.

#### Responsible Party Identification

John Williamson purchased the property in July 1977 and is a responsible party because he owned the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3), and had control over an UST at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

Kia Sumner purchased the property in April 2013 and is a responsible party because he owned the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3).
