Hi Eva, Hi Chris,

I've had a chance to focus on your letter of January 31, 2017, and thought it warranted to request a meeting to discuss options in moving the site forward. Essentially the two SCMs for the site are in conflict and need to be resolved. I can involve Dilan in the meeting, or potentially our new Supervisor, Paresh Khatri, since he has been most active in petroleum (LOP) cases.

In regards to the offsite well at 15962 Via Del Sol, would it be helpful if ACDEH were to send a letter to the property residents / property owners to see if County letter head might help get a response? (Assuming you've not obtained one yet).

Finally, have you conducted groundwater monitoring for the site this year? The higher groundwater levels may tell us something about contaminant distribution, especially with higher water levels. If not I can formally request it, if I need to. Let me know.
