Dear Mr. Pineda and Mr. Bansal:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) is reviewing the fuel case file for the above referenced site for potential case closure. Site investigation and groundwater monitoring from underground storage tank leaks have been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. Pursuant to Section 25297.15 (a), ACEH, the local agency, shall not consider cleanup or site closure proposals from the primary or active responsible party, issue a closure letter, or make a determination that no further action is required with respect to a site upon which there was an unauthorized release of hazardous substances from an underground storage tank subject to this chapter unless all current record owners of fee title to the site of the proposed action have been notified of the proposed action by the primary or active responsible party. ACEH is required to notify the primary or active responsible party of their requirement to certify in writing to the local agency that the notification requirement in the above-mentioned regulation has been satisfied and to provide the local agency with a complete mailing list of all record fee title owners.

To satisfy the above-mentioned requirement, please complete the enclosed "List of Landowners Form," and mail it back to ACEH within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. Also your comments must be considered prior to the proposed cleanup or closure. Please respond within 60 days from the date of this letter for your comments to be considered.

Public participation is a requirement for the Corrective Action Plan and case closure process. In order to notify potentially affected members of the public of the potential fuel leak case closure, we request that you distribute the attached Notification of Potential Case Closure to the addresses shown on attached mailing list and the cc list to this correspondence **no later than August 20, 2013**. We also request that you distribute the attached notification to any persons, corporations, or government agencies you are aware of that may have an interest in this fuel leak case. The Notification of Potential Case Closure requests that landowners or residents submit any comments or questions to ACEH regarding potential case closure by October 20, 2013. Notifications to duplicate addresses may be omitted. Following distribution by U.S. Mail to the attached mailing list, please submit written verification of the date that the Notification of Potential Case Closure was distributed. ACEH will consider all comments from the public prior to potential case closure.

Groundwater monitoring may be suspended at this time. In order to expedite the closure process, you may schedule well decommissioning for one to two weeks after the end of the public comment period. If public

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comments require a longer period of time for responses, it may be necessary to postpone well decommissioning.

## NOTIFICATION OF POTENTIAL CASE CLOSURE SHELL #13-5675 August 13, 2013

Site Location: 2120 Montana Street, Oakland, CA 94602 Fuel Leak Case RO0000173 and GeoTracker Global ID T0600101805

**Summary** – This fact sheet has been prepared to inform community members and other interested parties of potential case closure for a fuel leak case at the operating Shell-branded service station located at 2120 Montana Street in Oakland, California (see attached aerial photograph on back). Surrounding land use is mixed commercial and residential.

A potential gasoline release was observed in November 1997 when secondary containment was added to the three dispensers and turbine sumps. Up to 59 parts per million (ppm) Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), 0.76 ppm benzene, and 1.1 ppm MTBE were detected in three soil samples collected from beneath the dispensers


Site investigation activities to define the extent of petroleum hydrocarbons in soil and groundwater have included soil gas sampling, advancement of exploratory soil borings, and installation and sampling of 11 groundwater monitoring wells. A groundwater extraction (GWE) system was installed in March 2003. From April 2003 to March 2007, the GWE system removed approximately 769,943 gallons of groundwater that contained an estimated 21.8 pounds of TPHg, 0.826 pounds of benzene, and 4.87 pounds of MTBE

In November 2003, a small crack was found in the bottom of the regular-grade gasoline UST. After the crack was repaired, the UST passed a pressure test and was certified tight. The fuel dispensers and UST sumps were upgraded in May 2004. In November 2012, three 10,000-gallon USTs, dispensers, and piping were removed.

Site data indicate that a groundwater plume containing MTBE, TBA, and other dissolved petroleum hydrocarbons extended from the area of the fuel dispensers and underground storage tanks (USTs) southwest beneath Montana Street. Since 2001, the concentrations of dissolved petroleum hydrocarbons have decreased significantly. The plume appears to be shrinking in size and residual petroleum hydrocarbons in soil and groundwater are expected to biodegrade over time. The site has been evaluated in accordance with the State Water Resources Control Board Low-Threat Closure Policy. Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and it does not appear that the fuel release presents a risk to human health for nearby residents or site workers. Therefore, ACEH is considering potential closure of the fuel leak case.

**Next Step** – The public is invited to review and comment on the potential closure of the fuel leak case.
