Hi Tonya,

I wanted to followup our phone call from yesterday, and thought it best to get it in writing, especially since I was initially “talking out loud” about a mid September time frame for a part of it. But as background for future reference, Arcadis had requested an extension to the end of September for the submittal of a work plan due to having just picked up the site from CRA, with the submittal of an FS/CAP after the work had been conducted. Due to the situation (new site to Arcadis but with reasonably extensive pilot test data), it appears reasonable to modify the submittal timeline to September 14, 2012 for the submittal of a work plan and FS/CAP. If you believe further or alternative pilot tests are appropriate (a data gap work plan), please include those in the submittal. I’ll update Geotracker to reflect this change in a bit.

Otherwise, it was good to talk with you and introduce ourselves.
