

PHONE LOG (1802 Webster)

- 4/29/94 Mark Miller called to say that he still believes utility line investigations not required.
- 7/19/94 Mark Miller - stated that Weiss Assoc. has been retained to prepare a report/proposal addressing future anticipated work. The proposal will be submitted within 5 to 6 weeks. Copies of the wall destruction permits & Tank Removal Report will be submitted within 2 weeks. The work at site can be done after completion of site construction, which is projected to be completed by end of July '94.
- 8/22/94 Mr. Miller stated that he directed his consultant to conduct daily monitoring out at the site.

10/14/93 Gary Krambule, Alameda Bureau of Electricity 748-3986

Mr. Krambule stated that there are utility lines running along the east side of Webster St at 24" to 36" bgs. He will have access to maps next week.

10/14/93 Wali Wajiri, Alameda Public Works 748-4517
& Juliet Shui

Mr. Wajiri stated that there are sewer mains running along the center of Webster St. and Bona Vista Ave. In the vicinity of this site, these sewer mains are located about 6' bgs on Webster St. and 5 1/2' to 6' bgs along Bona Vista Ave. Approximately 200 feet east of Webster St on Bona Vista, the sewer main is located ~4' bgs. (It is an 8" sewer main).

11/15/93 Mark Miller requested some info on neighboring BP site.

4/26/94 Mark Miller stated that he would submit a schedule of work for the construction at the site & the relocation of destroyed wells. I also referred to Mark's April 19 '94 letter, where he stated that he didn't feel it was necessary to investigate potential migration along sewer lines. I told him that →

it was required because the gradient has gone towards the
northwest in the past, ~~and~~ towards Webster St., and
concentrations in B-3, located at west boundary of
site are high & wells B-7 has detected minor
concentrations indicating that the plume has in fact
migrated into Webster, & possibly into utility
trenches

Mr. Waziri stated that there are sewer mains running along the center of Webster St. and Buena Vista Ave. In the vicinity of the Chevron site, these sewer mains are located about 6 feet below ground surface on Webster St. and approximately 5.5 feet below ground surface along Buena Vista Ave. Approximately 200 feet east of Webster St. on Buena Vista, the sewer main is located approximately 4 feet below ground surface. (It is an 8-inch sewer main).
