

The above referenced site (see attached) is a fuel leak case that is under the regulatory oversight of the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health's (ACDEH) for the investigation and cleanup of petroleum hydrocarbon releases from four underground storage tanks (two 6,000-gallon gasoline tanks, one 550-gallon waste-oil tank, and one 1,000 gallon solvent tank). Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and it does not appear that residual contamination presents a risk to human health and the environment. Therefore, ACDEH is considering closure of this case. Due to the residual contamination at the site, the site would be closed with site management requirements that require further evaluation if the site is to be redeveloped in the future.

This notice is being sent to the current occupants and landowners of adjacent properties and known interested parties for this site. The public is invited to review and comment on the proposed closure of the case.
