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Hello Bob:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file including the *Work Plan for Additional Soil Sampling* (Work Plan) dated March 8, 2016, prepared and submitted on your behalf by Langan Treadwell Rollo (Langan) in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCBs) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP). The Work Plan describes soil sample collection via direct push sampling in the western portion of the site, near Webster Street for characterization of soil for offsite disposal during grading. The western portion of the site is not expected to have been impacted by the fuel release. Thank you for submitting the Work Plan.

Based on ACEH staff review of the work plan, the proposed scope of work is conditionally approved for implementation provided that the technical comment below is incorporated during the proposed work. Submittal of a revised work plan or a work plan addendum is not required unless an alternate scope of work outside that described in the work plan or these technical comments is proposed. We request that you address the following technical comments, perform the proposed work, and send us the report described below. Please provide 72-hour advance written notification to this office (e-mail preferred to: [karel.detterman@acgov.org](mailto:karel.detterman@acgov.org)) prior to the start of field activities.

#### **TECHNICAL COMMENTS**

- 1. Laboratory Analysis:** Because this is a fuel release case, analysis for VOCs including BTEX would appear appropriate.
- 2. Boring Logs:** Please include the boring logs with the letter report requested below.

This report is being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.
