Hi Barbara,

This email is to summarize adjustment of borings proposed in the work plan dated 25 November 2008. Per our telephone conversation last week, please find the figure showing the proposed revised boring locations to investigate potential residual contamination at the Site. The borings are located to specifically address residual contamination in the former UST excavation (UST-1), the potential for contaminant migration within the backfill of an excavation patch observed adjacent to the excavation (UST-3), as well as any potential down- or cross-gradient extent (UST-2 and UST-4). Otherwise, we will implement the program defined in the approved workplan dated 25 November 2008.

We are currently scheduled to start drilling on July 6th, and anticipate that initial results can be available to you by your July 13th due date. I will call you later today to discuss our locations, proposed scope, and scheduling (in hopes that you can stop by the site during field activities).
