

1. Prepared and submitted Second Quarter 2008 Status Report.

2. No environmental work was conducted at the Site during the Third Quarter of 2008.

WORK PROPOSED FOR NEXT QUARTER (Fourth Quarter 2008):

- 1. Prepared and submitted this Third Quarter 2008 Status Report (contained herein).
- 2. In accordance with ACEH direction, properly destroy the monitoring wells then prepare and submit a well decommissioning report to ACEH by 11 December 2008.

DISCUSSION:

BP received a letter dated 12 September 2008 from the ACEH stating that the ACEH and the California Regional Water Quality Control Board staff had reviewed the fuel leak case file with case closure summary and concurred that no further action related to the underground storage tank fuel release at the Site was required at this time. Within the 12 September 2008 letter, the ACEH continued that prior to issuance of a remedial action completion certificate the monitoring wells installed at the Site need to be properly destroyed, per California Water Code. Furthermore, the 17 September 2008 letter requested that a well decommissioning report be prepared and submitted to ACEH by 11 December 2008. Air knifing and destruction of the wells is tentatively scheduled for 23-24 October 2008. BP plans to submit the requested well decommissioning report to ACEH by the requested due date of 11 December 2008. A copy of the Site Map showing location of the monitoring wells to be destroyed is provided as Drawing 1.
