Gauging of all wells on a quarterly basis is not a requirement of the County for the site. However, the water level information should be collected if the information is needed as part of the evaluation of the remedial system. Therefore, the decision should be made on your end by whoever will be evaluating the performance of the remedial system and making future recommendations regarding operation of the system.
