**Subject:** Review of 9/22/11 Draft Corrective Action Plan

Paresh - I had a chance to review the draft Corrective Action Plan dated September 2011. I fully support the need to continue to remove contamination from the site.

I noted on page 7 of the report that describes past sampling the statement that ".. the County requested additional soil vapor investigation and indoor air sampling to evaluate potential risk to buildings occupants resulting from vapor intrusion." That is what I believe is still necessary in light of the fact that there has been no further indoor or outdoor air sampling since 2007 and soil testing still indicates PCE concentrations above acceptable limits. Testing along with independent expert evaluation of the results would give an unbiased perspective on the health risks to the faculty and children at the Montessori preschool. This up-to-date health risk perspective should be part of the Fact Sheet that is being distributed.
